Man sentenced for holding up Minneapolis bank

A 31-year-old man was sentenced last week in federal court in connection with the Feb. 28 robbery of the First National Bank of the Lakes in Minneapolis.

On Nov. 25 in Minneapolis, United States District Court Judge Ann Montgomery sentenced Cody Lyle Green, unknown address, to 57 months in prison and three years supervised release on one count of bank robbery. Green was charged on March 20 and pleaded guilty on May 29.

According to Green's plea agreement, he did by force, violence and intimidation, take approximately \$1,000 from a teller at the bank, located at 3100 Hennepin Ave.

This case was the result of an investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Minneapolis Police Department, and was prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Michael A. Dees.
