LONG BEACH MAN SENTENCED FOR THEFT OF GOVERNMENT PROPERTY

Gulfport, Miss. – Karl Hager, 54, of Long Beach, MS, was sentenced on Wednesday, October 6, 2010, to 4 years of probation and a \$5,000 fine for stealing property of the U.S. Navy while employed in the body shop of the Naval Construction Battalion Base in Gulfport, U.S. Attorney Donald R. Burkhalter announced today. Hager pled guilty to the charge before U.S. District Judge Louis Guirola, on June 27, 2010. The stolen property was recovered at Hager's home in Long Beach.

The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation along with the Naval Criminal Investigative Service and prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Annette Williams.
