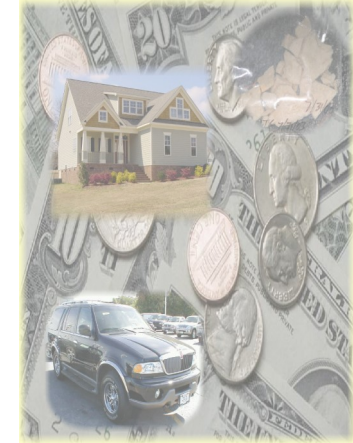

Training Focus

This course is designed to provide attendees with an understanding of the powerful law enforcement tool that is Asset Forfeiture. Asset Forfeiture is now recognized as an integral part of law enforcement efforts to curtail drug trafficking, money laundering, and other illegal activity through divesting criminals of their ill-gotten gains and using the funds and property for state and local law enforcement efforts. This conference is directed toward field officers and/or department asset forfeiture specialists who are likely to encounter cases with forfeiture potential as part of their routine duties or who would be responsible for supervising the development of such cases. The instruction is designed for experienced personnel and those who have little or no experience with a federal forfeiture program. An impressive group of instructors has been assembled to share their expertise from an agent's and attorney's perspective. Many innovative investigative techniques as well as instruction on forfeiture procedures will be shared with attendees.
