## **Fort Totten Man Sentenced for Abusive Sexual Contact**

**FARGO** - United States Attorney Drew Wrigley announced that on January 29, 2009, **Alfred Longie** of Fort Totten, North Dakota, was sentenced before United States District Court Judge Ralph R. Erickson on a conviction of abusive sexual contact.

**Longie**, 63, was found guilty by a 12-person jury on November 6, 2008, of abusive sexual contact with a 12-year-old female. During the evening of October 2, 2006, **Longie** provided alcohol to four juvenile females who were at his residence. The 12-year-old girl became intoxicated and went to sleep in one of the bedrooms at the residence. While she was sleeping **Longie** entered the bedroom, removed her garments, and had physical contact with her genitals.

Judge Erickson sentenced **Longie** to 24 months' imprisonment to be followed by a lifetime of supervised release. **Longie** was also ordered to pay a \$100 special assessment to the Crime Victim's Fund. Restitution for medical costs and counseling will be determined at a later date.
