I N F O R M A T I O N

The defendant having waived in open Court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE
(Carjacking)

On or about January 1, 2013, in Essex County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

BOBBY DAWSON,

with the intent to cause death and serious bodily harm, did knowingly take a motor vehicle that had been transported, shipped, and received in interstate and foreign commerce, namely, a silver four-door Mitsubishi Galant with Vehicle Identification Number 4A32B2FF6BE022243, from the person and presence of another, namely, "Victim One," by force and violence and by intimidation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2119(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNT TWO
(Hobbs Act Conspiracy)

From in or about December 2012, through in or about May 2013, in Union, Essex, and Bergen Counties, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

BOBBY DAWSON,

did knowingly and willfully conspire and agree with J.D. and A.Y. to obstruct, delay, and affect commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in commerce by robbery, as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(b)(1), and to commit and threaten physical violence to persons and property in furtherance thereof.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a).

COUNT THREE


(Discharging a Firearm During a Crime of Violence)

On or about April 1, 2013, in Essex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

BOBBY DAWSON,

during and in relation to a crime of violence for which the defendant may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, namely, the robbery of the MS&K Confectionery in Maplewood, N.J., which forms a part of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951(a), as charged in Count Two of this Information, did knowingly use and carry a firearm, which was discharged.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1)(A)(iii) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
