I N D I C T M E N T

The Grand Jury in and for the District of New Jersey,
sitting at Newark, charges:

COUNT ONE
DISPOSING FIREARM AND AMMUNITION TO CONVICTED FELON

1. At all times relevant to Count One of this
Indictment:

(a) Defendant ANTOINE DOBSON, who often goes by
the nickname "Ant," was employed as a Deputy United States
Marshal assigned to the Southern District of New York.

(b) Defendant LARRY LANGFORDDAVIS, who often goes
by the nickname "Lay Lay," was a close friend of defendant DOBSON
and someone whom defendant DOBSON represented to be a family
member in certain documentation. Defendant LANGFORDDAVIS also
was a convicted felon, having been convicted in the Superior
Court of New Jersey of the following crimes punishable by
imprisonment for a term exceeding one year:

June 2, 1994	Aggravated Assault - 2 nd degree (N.J.S.A. 2C:12-1(b)(1))	7 years
June 2, 1994	Robbery - 1 st degree (2C:15-1) and Conspiracy to Commit Robbery - 1 st degree (N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, 15-1)	15 years
May 24, 2002	Possession of Heroin with Intent to Distribute in a School Zone - 3 rd degree (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7)	4 years
May 24, 2002	Resisting Arrest - 4 th degree (N.J.S.A. 2C:29-2)	1 year, 6 months

(c) Defendant ANTOINE DOBSON owned a Glock model 27 .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, bearing serial number LSK711, that he purchased in or about November 2007. When purchasing the firearm, defendant DOBSON certified, on a document with United States Marshals Service letterhead and under penalty of perjury, that he would "use the requested firearm[] and/or large capacity ammunition feeding devices* for official use and

that the firearm and/or large capacity ammunition devices [were] not being acquired for personal use or for transfer or resale." Defendant DOBSON also possessed Speer .40 caliber hollow-point ammunition, which had been issued to him by the United States Marshals Service.

2. From on or about January 5, 2008, to on or about January 19, 2008, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

ANTOINE DOBSON, a/k/a "Ant,"

knowingly disposed of a firearm and ammunition, namely a Glock model 27 .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, bearing serial number LSK711, loaded with ten ("10") rounds of Speer .40 caliber hollow-point ammunition, to LARRY LANGFORDDAVIS, knowing and having reasonable cause to believe that LARRY LANGFORDDAVIS had been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(d)(1) and 924(a)(2) and Section 2.

COUNT TWO
POSSESSION OF FIREARM AND AMMUNITION BY CONVICTED FELON

1. Paragraph 1 of Count One of this Indictment is hereby realleged and incorporated as if set forth in full herein.

2. From on or about January 5, 2008, to on or about January 19, 2008, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendants

LARRY LANGFORDDAVIS, a/k/a "Lay Lay," and
ANTOINE DOBSON, a/k/a "Ant,"

did knowingly possess in and affecting commerce, a firearm and ammunition, namely a Glock model 27 .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, bearing serial number LSK711, loaded with ten ("10") rounds of Speer .40 caliber hollow-point ammunition, and aided and abetted the possession of the firearm and ammunition by defendant LARRY LANGFORDDAVIS, who had been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year in a court in the Superior Court of New Jersey.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2) and Section 2.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS

1. The allegations contained in Count Two of this Indictment are incorporated by reference as though set forth in full herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).

2. Upon conviction of the offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1) and Section 2 set forth in Count Two of this Indictment, the defendant,

ANTOINE DOBSON, a/k/a "Ant,"

shall forfeit to the United States any firearm and ammunition involved in or used in the commission of that offense, including the following:

a Glock model 27 .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, bearing serial number LSK711, and ten ("10") rounds of Speer .40 caliber hollow-point ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
