INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

On or about June 4, 2009, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **DANIEL F. MILLS**, having been convicted of aggravated assault upon a peace officer in Cause No. CR 2000-02979 and attempted aggravated battery against a household member (great bodily harm) in Cause No. CR 2000-04311 in the Second Judicial District Court, New Mexico, felony crimes punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting commerce, a firearm, a Hi-Point, model JCP, .40 caliber pistol, serial number X724331 and ten Speer brand .40 caliber cartridges of ammunition.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in this Indictment, the defendant, **DANIEL F. MILLS**, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c):

1. a Hi-Point, model JCP, .40 caliber pistol, serial number X724331; and

2. ten Speer brand .40 caliber cartridges of ammunition.
