Amended AFFIDAVIT

- 1) I am a regularly appointed Special Agent (SA) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) assigned to the Albuquerque Division of the FBI. I have been an SA for 1 year, and primarily investigate violent crimes on the Jicarilla Apache Indian Reservation. The following facts were determined during the course of an investigation conducted by agents of the FBI and Jicarilla Apache Police Department (JAPD) Criminal Investigator (CI) Lester Velarde.
- 2) The information set forth was provided from the JAPD, witnesses, and individuals involved. On February 8, 2010, the JAPD in Dulce, New Mexico, responded to the residence of Ouray Muskrat at 7 Cabin Lane, Dulce, New Mexico, for the report of a stabbing.
- 3) Ouray was having a superbowl party on February 7, 2010, at his house were the following people: Tara Muskrat (wife), Sunny Monarco, Jennifer Muskrat, Juan Medrano, Kyle Julian, Ali Tafoya, and his daughter. Some time after the superbowl was over, Ouray's wife Tara, told Ouray that Kyle had put his hand down her pants.
- 4) Ouray confronted Kyle about this and told him to leave, which then turned into a fight outside of the house between Kyle and Ouray. During the fight outside, Ouray remembers Kyle stabbing him in the back with a knife. Kyle's girlfriend, Ali, who was also outside picked up Kyle's knife off the ground during the fight. The knife is described as a black/grey handle,

Gerber pocket knife, with a see through design handle.

5) Juan was watching the fight in the front yard from a distance and heard Kyle say "I'm going to kill you Ouray". He then heard someone scream that a knife had been pulled out, so he went to break the fight up. Juan stepped into the fight to assist Ouray and separate the two because it appeared that Ouray was severely injured. He noticed a grey Gerber knife on the ground but didn't know how it got there. After separating them Kyle's girlfriend took Kyle and left.

- 6) Ouray was later transported to San Juan Regional Medical Center (SJRMC) where he was treated for multiple stab wounds in the back and a broken ankle. One of Ouray's lungs had been cut by the knife. The knife used in the incident was taken from Julian the next day and entered into evidence.
- 7) Kyle was interviewed and stated he was confronted by Ouray that night about an allegation that he touched his wife. When he was leaving Ouray's residence he claimed Ouray came after him with a knife. No other witnesses saw, including Kyle's girlfriend Ali, a knife in Ouray's hands. Kyle remembers pulling his knife out in his left hand and he may have stabbed Ouray. He also remembers Juan coming in and joining the fight.
- 8) Kyle Julian is an enrolled member of the Jicarilla Apache Tribe. The offense occurred within the exterior boundaries of the Jicarilla Apache Indian Reservation.
- 9) Based on the above, your affiant believes probable cause exists to believe Kyle Julian, an Indian person, committed the following offenses: Assault with a dangerous weapon, to wit a knife, with intent to do bodily harm, and without just cause or excuse, that is he assaulted Ouray Muskrat, an Indian person, by stabbing him with a knife, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 113(a) (3) and Title 18 United States Code, Section 2; and that the offense occurred in Indian Country, to wit the Jicarilla Apache Indian Reservation, in violation of Title 18, United States Code 1153.
