INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

On or between January 2, 2003, and March 5, 2003, in Indian Country, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **JAY FELIX JOHNSON**, an Indian, did knowingly cause Jane Doe to engage in a sexual act by using force against Jane Doe, and the sexual act consisted of penetration, however slight, of Jane Doe's vulva by the defendant's penis.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153, 2241(a) and 2246(2)(A).
