Based on the information set forth in this affidavit, 18 7. your affiant submits that there is probable cause to believe that 19 20 John Roybal, Sean Herrera and Christopher Whitsell possessed with the intent to distribute less than 100 kilograms of marijuana, 21 aiding and abetting, while possessing a firearm in relation to a 22 drug trafficking crime as described more fully above, in 23 violation of Title 21 U.S.C. 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(D), Title 18 24 U.S.C. 2 and Title 18 U.S.C. 924(c). 25
