Count 2: 18 U.S.C. §§ 2423(b) and (f): Travel with Intent to Engage in Illicit Sexual Contact.

INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

From on or about October 3, 2011, through or about October 24, 2011, in Curry County and elsewhere, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **JEFFREY NEAL JACKSON**, knowingly used a facility and means of interstate and foreign commerce, including email, a computer, and a cellular telephone, to knowingly persuade, induce, entice, and coerce, an individual he believed had not attained the age of 18 years, to engage in any sexual activity for which he could be charged with a criminal offense, that being criminal sexual penetration in the fourth degree in violation of N.M. Stat. Ann. § 30-9-11 (G).

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2422(b).
