INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about February 14, 2009, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, JORGE ALBERTO PAEZ MARISCAL and ALEJANDRO CRUZ, did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate and agree with each other and with other persons whose names are known and unknown to the grand jury to commit the following offense against the United States, to wit: possession with intent to distribute 5 kilograms and more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, contrary to 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846.

Count 2

On or about February 14, 2009, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, **JORGE ALBERTO PAEZ MARISCAL and ALEJANDRO CRUZ**, did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute 5 kilograms and more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.
