AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned, being duly sworn, hereby depose and state as follows:

1. I am a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and have been employed in that capacity for over thirteen years. I am currently assigned to the Albuquerque Division and investigate major crimes and other investigations including but not limited to violent crimes and bank robberies. The information set forth in this affidavit has been derived from my own investigation or communicated to me by other sworn law enforcement officers or from other reliable sources.

2. On September 23, 2009, the Compass Bank, 13140 Central Avenue, Southeast, Albuquerque, New Mexico, was robbed by an individual who entered the bank wearing a black ski-mask, carrying a black and red backpack, and yelling something to the effect of, "No silent alarms! Tellers, all your hundreds". The robber appeared to have something in his right hand that the tellers believed may have been a gun, but were unsure. The robber set the backpack on the teller counter and opened it saying words to the effect of, "Put all the money in the bag." The teller provided the robber with a sum of United States Federal Reserve Bank Notes. The robber demanded more money for the teller's other drawer and constantly reminded the bank employees not to activate any silent alarms.

1 Eventually after the teller put cash into the robber's backpack multiple times, the robber
2 turned and walked towards the bank's main doors. Before the robber left, the robber yelled
3 out something to the effect of, "No silent alarm or you all die." The robber was last seen
4 fleeing to the south on foot.

5
6 Compass Bank is a federally insured financial institution, and did sustain a
7 loss in United States Federal Reserve Bank Notes.

8
9 The aforementioned robbery was conducted by a man described as a Black
10 male, approximately 5'10"-6'0", medium to heavy build, medium black complexion, and a
11 deep and scratchy voice. The robber was further described as wearing a black ski-mask with
12 red and white stitching over the mouth, a big red and black puffy ski-jacket with a red hood,
13 blue jeans, black leather gloves, and a black backpack with some red streaks on it.

16 3. A source which has proven to be reliable in the past, directed the police
17 department to a vehicle traveling west on Interstate-40 (I-40) from Albuquerque. Officers
18 and detectives of the Albuquerque Police Department responded and observed a light blue
19 FreeStar Minivan driving westbound on I-40 without a license plate. The officers followed
20 the minivan to the Tahajaliee exit where they effected a car stop and an arrest when evidence
21 from the aforementioned bank robbery was visible in plain sight. The evidence seen was a
22 large sum of cash, a black ski-mask, a black and red puffy jacket with a red hood, black
23 gloves, and a black backpack with red dye stains on it.



25 The individual apprehended was Alan Curtis Tukes, date of birth 1951,
26 Social Security Account Number XXX-XX-5499.

1 4. Tukes also matched the ethnic background, height, and build of the bank
2 robber, as described, and had a previous conviction for bank robbery. Tukes also had a deep
3 tone to his voice.

5 Based on the information set forth in this affidavit, your affiant submits that
6 there is probable cause to believe that Alan Curtis Tukes, date of birth 1951, Social Security
7 Account Number XXX-XX-5499, did by intimidation and force, take money from the
8 persons and presence of the the Compass Bank, 13140 Central Avenue, Southeast,
9 Albuquerque, New Mexico, on September 23, 2009, a federally insured financial institution.

11 Your affiant further submits that these robberies was committed in violation
12 of Title 18 United States Code, Section 2113(a).
