## INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

## Count 1

On or about December 17, 2009, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico and elsewhere, the defendants, MIGUEL ANGEL DIAZ-GOMEZ, OMERO MENEDES ESCARENO, and OSCAR ARMANDO QUIROGA-GOMEZ, did unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate and agree with each other and with other persons whose names are known and unknown to the grand jury to commit the following offense against the United States, to wit: possession with intent to distribute 500 grams and more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, contrary to 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846.

## Count 2

On or about December 17, 2009, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, MIGUEL ANGEL DIAZ-GOMEZ, OMERO MENEDES

**ESCARENO, and OSCAR ARMANDO QUIROGA-GOMEZ**, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally did possess with intent to distribute 500 grams and more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.
