INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about September 23, 2008, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the Defendant, CEDRIC LARA, did receive, conceal, and unlawfully have in his possession stolen mail matter which had been stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted from a letter box and post office, mail receptacle, mail route and carrier which were authorized depositories for mail matter, knowing said mail matter to have been stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted from an authorized depository for mail matter. The piece of mail matter found in the unlawful possession of the Defendant, having been so stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted, was Target gift card #041206729500631 for \$50 that Marcia M., an individual known to the Grand Jury, had purchased and mailed on or about September 23, 2008.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1708.

Count 2

On or about October 3, 2008, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the Defendant, CEDRIC LARA, did receive, conceal, and unlawfully have in his possession stolen mail matter which had been stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted from a letter box and post office, mail receptacle, mail route and carrier which were authorized depositories for mail matter, knowing said mail matter to have been stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted from an authorized depository for mail matter. The pieces of mail matter found in the unlawful possession of the Defendant, having been so stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted, were Target gift cards #041206655950537 and #041206664683350 for \$75 each that Linda H., an individual known to the Grand Jury, had purchased and mailed on or about October 2, 2008.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1708.

Count 3

On or about October 19, 2008, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the Defendant, CEDRIC LARA, did receive, conceal, and unlawfully have in his possession stolen mail matter which had been stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted from a letter box and post office, mail receptacle, mail route and carrier which were authorized depositories for mail matter, knowing said mail matter to have been stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted from an authorized depository for mail matter. The piece of mail matter found in the unlawful possession of the Defendant, having been so stolen, taken, embezzled and abstracted, was Target gift card #041206742660032 for
