I, the complainant in this case, state that the following is true to the best of my knowledge and belief.




Melvin Douglas CARTER

On Sunday March 14, 2010, Alamogordo Department of Public Safety (DPS) Narcotics Enforcement Unit (NEU) Agent Joseph Singer obtained a state narcotic search warrant for the residence of Doug CARTER (Alias for Melvin Douglas CARTER) in Alamogordo, NM, from Otero County (NM) District Court Judge Jerry Ritter. On Thursday March 18, 2010, at approximately 6:34 a.m., Alamogordo DPS Emergency Response Team assisted Alamogordo DPS NEU with serving the search warrant at CARTER's residence located in Alamogordo, NM. The Alamogordo Emergency Response Team was requested to assist due to CARTER's violent crimes in the past.


The search warrant on CARTER's residence yielded two individual baggies which further contained approximately 23.86 grams (gross weight) of crack cocaine that later field tested positive for the properties of cocaine, a coffee mug which contained approximately 22.24 grams (gross weight) of crack cocaine and a glass smoking pipe used for smoking crack cocaine. Post Miranda, CARTER admitted to agents that the crack cocaine seized from his residence was his.

On April 4, 2010, CARTER was booked into the Otero County Detention Center on the state drug charges filed by Agent Singer. A report received from the New Mexico DPS Forensic Laboratory yielded 35.15 net grams of crack cocaine.

AUSA Michael Nammar authorized Federal prosecution of Melvin Douglas CARTER.
