INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

Beginning on or about August 23, 2010, and continuing to on or about August 24, 2010, in Doña Ana County, in the District of New Mexico and elsewhere, the defendants, ALICIA RAESHAUN UNGER, MARIO DEVONNE WASHINGTON SR., and MICHAEL MARTIN, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally did combine, conspire, confederate and agree with each other and with other persons whose names are known and unknown to the grand jury to commit the following offense against the United States, to wit: possession with intent to distribute marijuana, contrary to 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(D).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846.

Count 2

On or about August 24, 2010, in Dona Ana County, in the District of New Mexico and elsewhere, the defendants, ALICIA RAESHAUN UNGER, MARIO DEVONNE

WASHINGTON SR., and **MICHAEL MARTIN**, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally did possess with intent to distribute marijuana.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(D), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.
