8	AFFIDAVIT
9	I, the undersigned, being duly sworn, hereby depose and state as follows:

11	I am a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and have
12	been employed in that capacity for almost fourteen years. I am currently assigned to the
13	Albuquerque Division and investigate major crimes and conduct other investigations
14	including but not limited to violent crimes and bank robberies. The information set forth in
15	this affidavit has been derived from my own investigation or communicated to me by other
16	sworn law enforcement officers or from other reliable sources.
17	
18	2. On June 25, 2009, at approximately 9:30 a.m., the Compass Bank, 6001
19	Academy Road, Northeast (NE), Albuquerque, New Mexico (NM), was robbed by two
20	individuals who entered the bank together, but approached separate bank tellers, and
21	verbally demanded money. One robber displayed scissors while the other advised his
22	victim-teller that he had a gun. Both robbers used excessive vulgarity in very harsh tones
23	causing both tellers to fear for the physical welfare.
24	
25	The tellers provided the robbers with a large sum of United Stated Federal
26	Reserve Notes. The robbers were last seen by bank personnel fleeing the bank on foot in the
27	direction of north.

Compass Bank is a federally insured financial institution, and did sustain a large loss in United States Federal Reserve Notes.

The aforementioned robbery was conducted by two men described as young Black males.

The first Black male who displayed scissors was described as approximately 5'6"-5'8", medium black complexion, medium build, brown eyes, thin black mustache, and approximately 24-26 years in age. The robber was further described as wearing a white t-shirt, a navy blue baseball style cap with white lettering, and dark blue jeans.

The second Black male who threatened a handgun was described as approximately 5'8"-5'9", light black complexion, thin build, thin black mustache, and approximately early-20 years in age. The robber was further described as wearing a yellow zip-up "hoodie" with white horizontal stripes, a navy blue baseball style cap with white lettering, and navy blue jeans.

A source which has proven to be reliable in the past, directed the Albuquerque Police Department (APD) to 100 to 200 feet of 4537 Samara Road, Northwest, Albuquerque, New Mexico, at which time the source did not provide any further information. However, APD continued in the direction the source previously advised and observed two young black males fitting the description of the aforementioned bank robbers, getting into a vehicle. That vehicle was observed to pull into an address a block from 4537 Samara Road, Northwest (NW), Albuquerque, NM. APD detained the vehicle and immediately observed a pair of scissors on the dashboard.

1	4. Bank employees for the Compass Bank were taken by Albuquerque Police
2	Vehicle and viewed the two men detained from a safe distance. Both positively identified
3	the two men detained as the men who robbed their bank less than two hours before.
4	
5	The two men were then arrested and identified as Mondreon Yusun
6	Haywood, year of birth 1989, SSAN XXX-XX-9289, and Erik Michael Mathis, year of birth
7	1991, SSAN XXX-XX-7079. Mathis resided at 4537 Samara Road, NW, Albuquerque,
8	NM. APD, concerned that other people involved in the bank robbery, may be present at
9	4537 Samara Road, NW, Albuquerque, NM, requested permission from the homeowner,
10	Susan Hanna, Mathis' mother, to clear the house. Hanna gave APD her permission to clear
11	the house. During the course of a search for people, APD observed a large sum of cash
12	spread out across a bed. Also observed in plain view were evidence that left officers with a
13	clear impression that the currency was in fact, bank money.
14	
15	5. Haywood was taken to the FBI's Albuquerque Field Office where he was read
16	his Miranda Advice of Rights warning. Haywood waived his rights and affirmed that by
17	signing the document that advises the subjects wishes to cooperate. Haywood provided a
18	full confession to robbing the Compass Bank that included providing details of the bank
19	robbery not made available to the public.
20	
21	
22	6. On June 25, 2010, A search warrant was executed at 4537 Samara Road,
23	NW, Albuquerque, NM. Recovered from a bedroom identified by Susan Hanna as
24	belonging to Erik Michael Mathis, was a large sum of United States Federal Reserve Notes,
25	and other evidence related to bank robbery. The amount recovered was a \$10.00 difference
26	from the banks reported loss.

1	Based on the information set forth in this affidavit, your affiant submits that
2	there is probable cause to believe that Mondreon Yusun Haywood, year of birth 1989, SSAN
3	XXX-XX-9289, did by intimidation and force while armed with scissors, take money from
4	the persons and presence of the Compass Bank, 6001 Academy Road, NE, Albuquerque,
5	NM, on June 25, 2010, a federally insured financial institution.

8	Your affiant further submits that these robberies was committed in violation
9	of Title 18 United States Code, Section 2113(a)(d).
10
