AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

I, Brian Bridgeford, being duly sworn do hereby depose and swear as follows:

I am employed as a Special Agent with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) currently assigned to the Albuquerque District Office, Albuquerque, New Mexico.

This affidavit is made in support of a criminal complaint being filed against Damacio MOYA charging him with violating Title 21 USC 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(A) to wit: possession with intent to distribute 500 grams or more of methamphetamine.

On January 19, 2012, the DEA Albuquerque District Office received information from a Confidential Source of Information (CS) that Damacio MOYA was going to take possession of approximately two pounds of methamphetamine from an individual driving a black Chevrolet Impala. The information that the DEA received identified that MOYA was going to meet with the black Impala at the Wal-Mart located on the corner of Rio Bravo Boulevard and Coors Boulevard in Southwest Albuquerque. The CS further stated that MOYA would most likely be driving a white Dodge Ram pickup truck.

At approximately 6:27 PM on January 19, 2012, DEA agents were conducting surveillance at the Wal-Mart located at the corner of Rio Bravo Boulevard and Coors Boulevard. At this time, an agent observed a white Dodge pickup truck bearing New Mexico license plate 682RJD. New Mexico license plate 682RJD is registered to Damacio MOYA at 10314 Rafael Rd SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico. Agents then observed the white Dodge Pickup truck park near a black Impala. Agents then observed MOYA get out of the pickup truck, empty handed, and entered into the Impala. A short time later, agents observed MOYA exit the Impala carrying a green in color bag. As MOYA approached the white Dodge pickup truck, agents approached MOYA and took MOYA into custody. Inside the green bag, agents observed two ziplock bags containing a white crystal substance.

The two ziplock bags containing methamphetamine weighed approximately 948 gross grams. The methamphetamine was field tested and tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine.

For the reasons set forth above, SA Brian Bridgeford respectfully requests the court to approve this criminal complaint charging Damacio MOYA with violation of Title 21 USC 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(A), to wit: possession with intent to distribute over five hundred (500) grams or more of methamphetamine.

This affidavit is submitted for the limited purpose of providing probable cause to support the attached criminal complaint. I have not set forth each and every fact learned during the course of this investigation in the above affidavit. Affiant respectfully requests the approval of this criminal complaint for Damacio MOYA charging him with violating Title 21 USC 841, to wit: possession with intent to distribute over five hundred 500 grams or more of methamphetamine.
