14	Your Affiant, Victoria M. Ryder, having been first duly
15	sworn, does hereby depose and state as follows:
16	
17	1. Your Affiant is a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of
18	Investigation (FBI). Your Affiant has been a Special Agent
19	(SA) since August, 2009. Your Affiant is currently assigned to
20	the Albuquerque Field Office, with a primary duty to
21	investigate civil rights and individuals involved in the on-
22	line sexual exploitation of children.
23	
24	2. Your Affiant has participated in investigations of persons
25	suspected of violating federal child pornography and
26	exploitation laws. Your Affiant has also participated in
27	training, including the Internet Crimes Against Children
28	Conference in Atlanta, Georgia in 2012, for the investigation

and enforcement of federal child pornography and exploitation laws in which computers are used as the means for receiving, transmitting, possessing, and distributing images depicting minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct (hereafter referred to as "child pornography"). Your Affiant has received training in peer to peer investigations involving computers and child pornography, and viewed numerous images and videos of child pornography in investigations. Your Affiant has received training and gained experience in interviewing and interrogation techniques, arrest procedures, search warrant applications, the execution of searches and seizures, computer evidence identification, computer evidence seizure and processing, and various other criminal laws and procedures. Your Affiant has personally participated in the execution of search warrants involving the search and seizure of computer equipment.

3. This affidavit will show there is probable cause in 18 support of a criminal complaint against Arnold Gonzales, 19 (Year of Birth 1985, SSN xxx-xx-6028), for a violation of 18 20 U.S.C. §§ 2423(b) and (f), that being, a person who travels in 21 interstate commerce, for the purpose of engaging in any 22 illicit sexual conduct with a person under 18 years of age; 23 and for a violation of 18 USC § 2422(b), that being a person 24 who uses the mail or any facility or means of interstate or 25 foreign commerce to knowingly persuade, induce, entice or 26 coerce any individual who has not obtained the age of 18 27

years to engage in any sexual act for which any person can be charged with a criminal offense.

4. The statements contained in this affidavit are based upon Your Affiant's investigation, training, experience, and information provided by other law enforcement officers known to be reliable. Because this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing an arrest warrant, Your Affiant has not included each and every fact known to me concerning this investigation. Your Affiant has set forth only the facts that Your Affiant believes are necessary to establish probable cause to support a criminal complaint against Arnold Gonzales, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2423(b) and(f), and 18 USC § 2422(b).

#### II. <u>RELEVANT STATUTES</u>

This investigation concerns alleged violations of 18 17 5. U.S.C. §§ 2423(b) and(f), a person who travels in interstate 18 commerce, for the purpose of engaging in any illicit sexual 19 conduct with a person under 18 years of age; and 18 USC § 20 2422(b), a person who uses the mail or any facility or means 21 of interstate or foreign commerce to knowingly persuade, 22 induce, entice or coerce any individual who has not obtained 23 the age of 18 years to engage in any sexual act for which any 24 person can be charged with a criminal offense. 25

#### DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION III.

6. On April 24, 2012, Agent Phil Caroland from the Curry County Sheriff's Department placed an online advertisement on http://www.craigslist.com, in the Lubbock, Texas area, in the "Women Seeking Men" section of "Casual Encounters." Caroland's posting was entitled "CUTE/YOUNG IF AGE DOESN'T MATTER HIT ME UP!!!!!"

7. On April 24, 2012 at 11:15 hours, Caroland received an email from email address arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com that read "I'm 26, 5'9" 190 pounds Hispanic." Two pictures were attached to the email. Once image was of male in a t-shirt, 12 wearing glasses. The second image was of a male in what appeared to be a military uniform with a name tag reading 14 "Gonzales." The two pictures appeared to be of the same 15 Hispanic male. Caroland responded to the email and stated, 16 "I have a couple of pics...I am live in Clovis, I am in 7th 17 grade and 12 yrs old...parents are in the air force...we are 18 moving to Germany in 2 weeks." 19

8. Caroland received an email from arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com 21 that asked for a picture. Caroland sent an age-regressed 22 picture of a female Clovis Police Department employee and 23 said her name was Jill Spencer. The age-regressed photo sent 24 to arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com was consistent with a photograph 25 of a minor female. Caroland received an email from 26 arnoldgonzales10gmail.com stating Clovis is far from Lubbock, 27 and that he lives in Lubbock. A few hours later, Caroland 28

received several emails from arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com. The emails stated Jill was under eighteen (18), which is too young and that he was just passing through Lubbock, Texas. The sender from arnoldgonzales10gmail.com asked if she understood. Caroland responded "yep, I understand, that's cool...take care."

9. On April 26, 2012, at 1:47 pm, Caroland received an email from <u>arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com</u> that said "Hey I'm bored." Caroland and arnoldgonzales10gmail.com continued to email 10 back and forth until approximately 5:00 pm, when Caroland 11 stated Jill's mom would be home soon. 12 arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com asked for Jill's phone number, 13 which Caroland provided. Caroland instructed 14 arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com not to text on the weekends because 15 Jill's parents check the phone. 16

10. On April 29, 2012, Caroland received an email from 18 arnoldgonzales1@gmail.com that he had Jill's number. On 19 April 30, 2012, Caroland received a text message from 20 (907)306-0164 ("cell phone 907"). Caroland and cell phone 21 907 texted back and forth, and Caroland received a text 22 message from cell phone 907 requesting she send nude pictures 23 of herself. Caroland received another text message from cell 24 phone 907 that the subject wanted the pictures "nude, with 25 your pussy spread open and ass." Caroland texted that Jill 26 did not have a camera. Caroland received a text message from 27

cell phone 907 that the subject would send nude ones back once the subject received them from her.

11. On May 1, 2012, Caroland received more text messages from cell phone 907. The text messages talked about different sexual positions the subject wanted to do to her, to include that he wanted to "fuck her face," do it "doggystyle," an wanted her to "suck him." The subject also described the size of the subject's penis, and asked where they could meet for a sexual encounter if the subject came 10 down to Clovis. Caroland texted cell phone 907 that they 11 could meet at Jill's parents' house if they were at work, or 12 at the Java Loft. Caroland received a text from cell phone 13 907 that the subject's car was too small and too compact to 14 have any fun in. Caroland received a text from cell phone 15 907 asking what hours Jill's parents worked and if Jill knew 16 what time they came home. Caroland received a text from cell 17 phone 907 that said the subject would come to Clovis, New 18 Mexico to have sex with Jill the next day after lunch. 19

12. On May 1, 2012, at approximately 9:50 pm, Caroland 21 received text messages from cell phone 907. The text 22 messages asked if the subject could bring a video camera with 23 him and film Jill having sex with the subject and giving the 24 subject oral sex. Caroland received a text message from cell 25 phone 907 that the subject would not show the video to anyone 26 else. During the text messaging on May 1, 2012, Caroland 27 told the subject that Jill's parents were too strict, and 28

that in three more years, when she was 15, things would be better.

13. On May 2, 2012, Caroland received a text message from cell phone 907 that the subject still planned to come to Clovis, New Mexico after lunch. Caroland received text messages from cell phone 907 asking about where Jill's parents worked and what rank Jill's dad was in the Air Force.

On May 2, 2012, Caroland texted an address to cell phone 14. 10 907 where they could meet in Clovis, New Mexico. At 11 approximately 1:45, a man arrived at the provided address in 12 a 2011 gray Ford Focus, United States Government plate 13 G132845L. The occupant exited his vehicle, walked across the 14 street, approached the decoy house, and entered the front 15 16 door. The occupant of the vehicle then fled on foot after CCSO identified themselves and ordered him to the ground. 17 CCSO pursued and arrested the man, who was identified as 18 Arnold Gonzales, year of birth 1985, SSN XXX-XX-6028. 19 20 Gonzales had a condom in his pocket upon his arrest. Gonzales also had a receipt in his pocket from May 2, 2012, 21 for a purchase of Pepto Bismol at gas station in Canyon, 22 Texas. 23

25 15. Gonzales was Mirandized and interviewed by Caroland. In
26 the recorded interview, Gonzales told Caroland he was in
27 Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on May 1, 2012, for an Army meeting.
28 Gonzales was on-duty today, and drove from Oklahoma City,

Oklahoma, with his final destination planned as Midland, 1 Texas. Gonzales stated he lives in Midland, Texas. Gonzales 2 said Clovis, New Mexico, was about an hour out of his route, 3 and he came to New Mexico to meet the girl he was texting. 4 Gonzales stated he was told she was twelve years old, and he 5 had no reason not to think she was twelve, but he was only 6 going to have sex with her if she was eighteen years of age 7 or older. Gonzales said he just came to New Mexico to find 8 out how old she was. Gonzales stated he "took the text 9 messaging sexual," and although he texted he was going to 10 11 video tape the sexual encounter, he was just kidding. Gonzales stated he communicated using his cellular telephone, 12 and accessed his email using his cellular telephone. 13 Gonzales voluntarily showed Caroland his cell phone, a 14 Samsung Smart Phone. Gonzales put in his cellular telephone 15 password, and showed Caroland the text messages. Caroland 16 identified the text messages as the text messages exchanged 17 between Caroland and cell phone 907 described above. 18

16. Caroland obtained a search warrant from a State District 20 Court Judge to search the Ford Focus driven by Gonzales. The search yielded the following:

- May 1, 2012, Sleep Inn and Suites receipt, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, (check-in on May 1, 2012, check out on May 2, 2012)
- May 2, 2012, 12:18 pm, Allsups #166 receipt, 302 North 15th Street, Canyon, Texas

17. Kirk Roberts, Curry County Sheriff's Office, interviewed Captain James LaPointe, United States Army. LaPointe confirmed that Gonzales is a United States Army employee, rank E5, with the US Army Recruiting Station in Midland, Texas. LaPointe stated that the Ford Focus was issued to Gonzales just for his recruiting trip to Oklahoma. LaPointe stated Gonzales was on duty May 1, 2012 and on May 2, 2012, and was scheduled to be back in Midland, Texas on May 2, 2012. LaPointe stated Gonzales had no reason to be in New 10 Mexico. LaPointe informed Roberts that Gonzales' work 11 computer had been taken from him some time ago, and an 12 investigation was being conducted for sexual misconduct. 13

#### IV. INTERSTATE NEXUS

18. Based upon the statement by Gonzales to the interviewing 16 agents, Gonzales admitted to traveling from Oklahoma City, 17 Oklahoma, to Clovis, New Mexico in a vehicle so as to satisfy 18 interstate nexus. The physical evidence found in the Ford 19 20 Focus driven by Gonzales corroborates this admission. Thus, 21 Your Affiant believes interstate commerce is satisfied for purposes of a violation of 18 USC §§ 2423(b) and(f). 22 Additionally, because Gonzales used Craigslist, accessible 23 via the Internet and his cellular telephone to communicate 24 with Caroland, Your Affiant believes a facility or means of 25 26 interstate nexus is satisfied for purposes of a violation of 18 USC § 2422(b). 27

3	submits there is probable cause to believe that Arnold		
4	Gonzales violated 18 U.S.C. §§ 2423(b) and (f), that being, a		
5	person who travels in interstate commerce, for the purpose of		
6	engaging in any illicit sexual conduct with a person under 18		
7	years of age; and 18 USC §§ 2422(b), that being, a person who		
8	uses the mail or any facility or means of interstate or		
9	foreign commerce to knowingly persuade, induce, entice or		
10	coerce any individual who has not obtained the age of 18		
11	years to engage in any sexual act for which any person can be		
12	charged with a criminal offense. Your Affiant requests this		
13	Court issue a criminal complaint in this matter charging		
14	Arnold Gonzales with a violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2423(b) and		
15	(f), and 18 USC §§ 2422(b).
