Early this morning, Michael Metter, the Chief Executive Officer and President of Spongetech Delivery Systems, Inc. ("Spongetech"), and Steven Moskowitz, Spongetech's Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Chief Accounting Officer, Treasurer, and Secretary, were arrested pursuant an arrest warrants issued by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York. The warrants were based on a sealed criminal complaint charging Metter and Moskowitz with conspiracy to commit securities fraud and obstruction of justice. After the arrests, the criminal complaint was unsealed and made public. A copy has been posted on this website.

Federal law provides that crime victims have the right to "reasonable, accurate, and timely notice of any public court proceeding" and the right to "be reasonably heard at any public proceeding" involving bail. The defendants' initial appearances

are scheduled to be held at or about 2:00 p.m. today before  
United States Magistrate Judge Ramon E. Reyes, Jr., at the United  
States Courthouse, 225 Cadman Plaza East, Brooklyn, New York.
