ACTING UNITED STATES ATTORNEY ANDREW T. BAXTER announced that DANNY ALDIN, age 48, of Israel, pled guilty today to illegally reentering the United States after removal, before United States District Court Judge Glenn T. Suddaby, in Albany, New York. Sentencing for DANNY ALDIN is scheduled for May 14, 2009 in Albany, New York. As a result of the conviction ALDIN faces a maximum sentence of imprisonment of up to 20 years, supervised release of up to 3 years, a fine of up to \$250,000, and a special assessment of \$100.

ALDIN, a citizen of Israel, was physically removed from the United States (Newark, New Jersey) to Israel on October 28, 2008. On November 15, 2008, ALDIN was encountered and arrested as an illegal alien by United States Border Patrol Agents in Champlain, New York.

This matter was investigated by the United States Border Patrol, Champlain, New York and the New York State Police.
