MILLET SENTENCED TO 38 MONTHS IN JAIL

BUFFALO, N.Y. – **VINCENTE MILLET**, 27, of Buffalo, NY, who pled guilty on April 13, 2009, to an Indictment charging him with conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute and to distribute cocaine, was sentenced July 21, 2009, to a term of 38 months in prison by Chief Judge Richard J. Arcara, U.S. District Court, Acting U.S. Attorney Kathleen M. Mehlretter of the Western District of New York announced today.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Thomas S. Duszkiwicz, who handled the case, stated that the defendant was arrested on Nov. 5, 2007, and charged with a conspiracy to sell quantities of cocaine to a confidential informant working for the Drug Enforcement Administration. AUSA Duszkiwicz indicated that the defendant was arrested in his vehicle in possession of approximately 5 ozs. of cocaine after his co-conspirator had just been arrested outside the car trying to sell an additional 4 ozs. of cocaine.

AUSA Duszkiwicz noted that the street value of the over 9 ozs. of cocaine exceeds \$25,000.

The conviction was the culmination of an investigation on the part of Special Agents of the Drug Enforcement Administration under the direction of Resident Agent in Charge Charles Tomaszewski.
