## **FORMER SODUS POINT POSTMASTER INDICTED**

ROCHESTER, N.Y.-A Federal grand Jury in Rochester has returned a two count Indictment charging NANCY A. ROLOSON , 53, of Sodus, New York, with Theft of Government Property and Misappropriation of Postal Funds. Each charge carries a maximum penalty of 10 years in prison, a fine of up to \$250,000, or both.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Craig R. Gestring, who presented the evidence to the Grand Jury, stated that the Indictment charges the defendant with conduct related to the theft of over \$6,000 in United States Currency from the Sodus Point, New York Post Office, where the defendant was working as the Postmaster.

The Indictment was the culmination of an investigation on the part of the United States Postal Service - Office of Inspector General under the direction of Special Agent in Charge Joseph Finn.

The defendant will be arraigned before the Honorable Marion W. Payson in United States Magistrate Court.

The fact that a defendant has been charged with a crime is merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
