FORMER SODUS POINT POSTMASTER CHARGED WITH STEALING MONEY FROM HER POST OFFICE

ROCHESTER, N.Y.--NANCY A. ROLOSON , 53, of Sodus, New York, was charged with Theft of Government Property announced U.S. Attorney Kathleen M. Mehlretter. The charge carries a maximum penalty of 10 years in prison, a fine of up to \$250,000, or both.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Craig R. Gestring, who is handling the case, stated that the defendant was the Postmaster for Sodus Point, N.Y in 2008. As Postmaster, Roloson was responsible for all the cash, stamps, money orders and other accountable items at the Sodus Point Post Office. Today, Roloson was charged in Federal Court with stealing several thousand dollars from her Post Office during the time she was Postmaster.

The complaint was brought as a result of an investigation on the part of the United States Postal Service - Office of Inspector General under the direction of Special Agent in Charge Joseph Finn.

The fact that a defendant has been charged with a crime is merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
