THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT 1

On or about February 18, 2012, in the District and State of Oregon and elsewhere, CHRISTOPHER LEE CARLSON, defendant herein, did knowingly deposit in a post office and in an authorized depository for mail matter to be sent and delivered by the Postal Service, and knowingly caused to be delivered by the postal service according to the direction thereon, a communication addressed to Speaker John Boehner, a member of the House of Representatives who is an official covered by 18 U.S.C. § 1114, containing a threat to injure the person of the addressee of the letter and another, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 876(c).

COUNT 2

From on or about February 20, 2012, to on or about February 24, 2012, in the District and State of Oregon and elsewhere, **CHRISTOPHER LEE CARLSON**, defendant herein, did engage in conduct with intent to convey false or misleading information, in that he mailed a letter addressed to Senator Barbara Mikulski in Baltimore, Maryland, which indicated that it may contain a lethal pathogen to which the recipient may have been exposed, under circumstances where such information may reasonably be believed and where such information indicates that an activity has taken, is taking, or will take place that would constitute a violation of Chapter 10 of Title 18 of the United States Code, that is, Title 18, United States Code, Section 175, relating to biological weapons, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1038(a).
