

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 30, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

RODNEY FIELDS

knowingly and unlawfully took from employees of the 3rd Federal Bank, located at 6633 Roosevelt Boulevard, money, that is, approximately \$188 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of, the 3rd Federal Bank the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 30, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

RODNEY FIELDS

knowingly and unlawfully took from employees of the Sovereign Bank, located at 9200 Roosevelt Boulevard, money, that is, approximately \$581 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of, the Sovereign Bank the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 1, 2006, in Huntingdon Valley, Montgomery County, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendants

**RODNEY FIELDS and
CRAIG BUSILLO**

knowingly and unlawfully attempted to take, and aided and abetted the attempted taking of, from employees of the Citizens Bank, located at 763 Huntingdon Pike, money, that is, United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of, the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and 2.

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 1, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendants

**RODNEY FIELDS and
CRAIG BUSILLO**

knowingly and unlawfully took, and aided and abetted the taking of, from employees of the Beneficial Savings Bank, located at 1411 Rhawn Street, money, that is, approximately \$853 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of, the Beneficial Savings Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and 2.
