INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about November 12, 1997, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JAMES R. JONES,
a/k/a "CS,"

knowingly and willfully made false statements in an application for an United States passport, with intent to induce and secure for his own use, the issuance of a passport under the authority of the United States, contrary to the laws regulating the issuance of passports and the rules prescribed pursuant to such laws, that is, defendant JONES stated that he was a person identified here as "CS," that he was born in 1977, and that he had a Social Security

Number ending in 1251, which statements he knew to be false.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1542.
