

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 5, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the TD Bank North, located at 1607 Walnut Street in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$705 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the TD Bank North, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 8, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Sovereign Bank, located at 1101 Market Street in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$720 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Sovereign Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 11, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Citizen's Bank, located at 5500 Germantown Avenue in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$90 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Citizen's Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FIVE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 11, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the PNC Bank, located at 150 W. Chelton Avenue in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1675 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the PNC Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT SIX

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 15, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Wachovia Bank, located at 5119 Frankford Avenue in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,300 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Wachovia Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT SEVEN

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 21, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Sovereign Bank, located at 2000 Market Street in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,266 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Sovereign Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT EIGHT

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 6, 2006, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Sovereign Bank, located at 1501 East Erie Avenue in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,349 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Sovereign Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT NINE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 11, 2006, in Upper Darby, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH SAUNDERS

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Wachovia Bank, located at 18 Garrett Road in Upper Darby, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,970 in United States currency, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Wachovia Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
