INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 31, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

CHRISTOPHER HARLEY

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Citizens Bank, located at 1735 Market Street, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,000 in United States currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of the Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and in so doing, knowingly and unlawfully assaulted and put in jeopardy the lives of the employees of the Citizens Bank and others by use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a loaded Ruger .357 Magnum revolver, serial number 573-95248.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(d).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 31, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

CHRISTOPHER HARLEY

knowingly used and carried a firearm, that is, a loaded Ruger .357 Magnum revolver, serial number 573-95248, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, armed bank robbery, in violation of Title 18 of the United States Code section 2113(d).

In violation of Title 18 of the United States Code Section 924(c)(1)(A)(iii).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:


As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c),
