DURING FISCAL YEAR 1960

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - During fiscal year 1960, the 30,617 criminal cases filed represented a decrease of 2.3 per cent from the number filed in the previous years. 21 types of violations with 200 or more cases comprised 84.8 per cent of the total filed; 11 showed increases while 10 showed decreases. The largest increases occurred in Counterfeiting and Forgery (2,116 to 2,271); Crimes on Federal Reservations (499 to 660). Narcotics violations (1,638 to 1,721) and Liquor Law (3,920 to 4,018) showed increases while Criminal Tax (1,012 to 754) showed a substantial decline. Increases took place in 41 districts ranging from 282 in Southern California to 1 in Southern Mississippi while decreases ranging from 506 in the District of Columbia to 2 in Eastern Michigan occurred in 48 districts, Rhode Island with 44 cases and South Dakota with 99 cases had the same number as in fiscal year 1959.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated dropped from 30,929 in the previous year to 30,462 in fiscal year 1960, a decrease of 1.5 per cent. Of the 30,462 cases closed, 22,615 (having 27,645 defendants) were by plea of guilty; 2,380 (involving 3,310 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 830 (with 1,373 defendants) not guilty.

PENDING - The number of cases pending as of the close of year rose to 7,820 a 2.0 per cent increase over the 7,665* pending as of June 30, 1959. 6,252 of the cases were in a triable status while 1,568 were in a fugitive or other status beyond the control of United States Attorneys.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury Proceedings comprised of 14,088 indictments and 558 No True Bills amounted to 14,646 a drop of 4.9 per cent from the 15,397 such proceedings in fiscal year 1959.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received in United States Attorneys' offices increased very slightly to 106,994 (less than .1 of one per cent from the 106,915 complaints received in fiscal year 1959). 70 per cent of them were in eleven types of violations. 15,837 National Motor Vehicle Theft Act complaints comprised 14.8 per cent of the total. Frauds against the government and Counterfeiting and Forgery complaints were the next highest with 10,217 and 9,527 respectively. 45,166 complaints or 42.2 per cent of the total were received in 14 districts. Southern California with 6,902 had the most complaints. Southern Florida with 4,054 and Southern New York with 4,029 were the next highest.

CLOSED - 77,347 complaints were closed during fiscal year 1960 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 69,931 with 87,514 defendants were closed by declination of prosecution.

PENDING - For the second year in succession United States Attorneys closed the fiscal year with less than 10,000 complaints pending in their offices. The 9,426 pending as of June 30, 1960 was 428 or 4.3 per cent less than the number pending as of June 30, 1960.

CIVIL SUITS

FILED - For the third year in a row, civil suits filed exceeded 24,000. The 24,382 filed in fiscal year 1960 represented an increase of 1.4 per cent

over the preceding year. Compared to fiscal year 1958 when the all-time high of 24,573 was reached, this total is 191 cases or .8 per cent lower. A total of 50 districts had increases; one had the same number and 40 had decreases. Minnesota and Southern California had the largest increases with 305 and 259 respectively while Southern New York and Massachusetts decreased by 276 and 169 respectively. Negotiable instrument cases with 4,743 decreased by 303 and Veterans' cases with 3,338 decreased by 125. Tax cases with 5,418 were up over the previous year by 226.

TERMINATED - With 56 districts showing decreases, Civil suits terminated dropped from 24,507 in fiscal year 1959 to 23,457 in fiscal year 1960, a drop of 1,050 or 4.3 per cent. Decreases ranged from 227 in Southern Florida to 5 in Eastern New York. Increases ranged from 1 in Western North Carolina to 251 in Minnesota.

PENDING - The backlog of civil pending cases increased by 5.1 per cent to 19,231. 10,170 or 52.9 per cent were in 18 districts with caseloads ranging from 302 in Western New York to 1,120 in Eastern New York. Except for Tax lien cases which rose from 2,554 to 3,034, the major types of civil cases showed changes of less than 100 cases each from the June 30, 1959 figures. Tax cases (3,014 to 3,093) Contract actions (2,009 to 2,041) and Lands actions (3,290 to 3,385) showed increases while Veterans' cases with 1,507 and Torts cases with 1,957 decreased from 1,519 and 1,984 respectively.

CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil matters received by United States Attorneys' offices amounted to 32,321, second only to fiscal year 1958 when the all-time high of 32,660 was reached. Negotiable instrument matters with 7,216 and

Veterans' matters with 4,531 comprised 22.3 and 14.0 per cent of the total respectively.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 9,309 an increase of 90 over the previous fiscal year.

PENDING - 11,643 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1960 as compared to 12,978 as of June 30, 1959. This is a decrease of 1,335 or 10.3 per cent, and represents a decrease of 10,901 from the 22,544 pending as of June 30, 1954. The following table shows how United States Attorneys have reduced the number of civil matters pending at the close of the past seven fiscal years.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for fiscal year 1960 decreased by 6.2 per cent to \$32,964,349. This is the fifth highest total collected in any fiscal year and in addition is the fifth time in the history of the Department that collections have exceeded \$30,000,000 during a fiscal year. It is noteworthy that this has happened four times in the last five fiscal years.

The \$32,964,349 collected represents a return of \$2.48 for each dollar of the \$13,282,000 appropriated for United States Attorneys' offices for the year ending June 30, 1960.

SAVINGS

\$42,315,549 was saved in 1,166 of the 23,457 civil suits terminated in which the government as defendant was sued for a total of \$54,479,490. This is \$8,401,670 or 16.6 per cent less than the \$50,717,219 saved in fiscal year 1959.

PERSONNEL

During the year, an average of 1,613 employees were employed in United States Attorneys' offices; 300 employees were appointed and 332 separated, a net loss of 32 employees, and 1,591 employees were on the rolls as of June 30, 1960. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney decreased by 8 to 130 while cases terminated dropped from 94 to 86.

CASES PENDING IN UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES




CHART NO. 2

Thousands of Cases



TOTAL 7,820 CASES




CHART NO. 4

TOTAL 7,820 CASES




CHART NO. 5

TOTAL 7,820 CASES




CHART NO. 6
CRIMINAL CASES FILED




CHART NO. 7
CRIMINAL CASES FILED




CHART NO. 8
PROCEEDINGS BEFORE GRAND JURY




CHART NO. 9
CRIMINAL CASES TERMINATED



TRIALS IN CRIMINAL CASES




CHART NO. II
U. S. CIVIL CASES PENDING



TOTAL 19,231 SUITS



TOTAL 19,231 SUITS




CHART NO. 14
AGE OF CIVIL SUITS PENDING AS OF JUNE 30, 1960




CHART NO. 15
CIVIL CASES FILED




CHART NO. 16
CIVIL MATTERS RECEIVED



CIVIL CASES TERMINATED



APPROPRIATIONS AND COLLECTIONS





