WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICES  
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1977

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 38,452 showed a decrease of 5,720 or 12.95 percent less than the number filed in the previous fiscal year. 72.66 percent of the total was in 14 offenses having 800 or more cases. The greatest volume of filings were in Controlled Substances (5,243), Postal Crimes (3,205), Weapons Control (3,032), Frauds vs/ Government (2,863), Bank Robbery (1,918), Immigration (1,341), Stolen Property (1,231), and National Motor Vehicle Act (1,133). Increases took place in 28 districts ranging from 1 in Mississippi Northern and North Carolina Eastern to 614 in Georgia Middle. Decreases took place in 65 districts ranging from 1 in Gaum and Rhode Island to 605 in California Central.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated decreased 4,439 or 9.73 percent less than the previous year's total. Of the total or 41,229 closed, 27,372 involving 35,252 defendants were pleas of guilty, 4,001 (involving 5,868 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 859 (involving 1534 defendants) were found not guilty (including 5 not guilty verdicts by reason of insanity).

PENDING - With 24,218 cases, the pending caseload showed a decrease of 10.29 percent less than the 26,995\* cases pending at the close of fiscal year 1976. Of the pending cases, 9,752 cases were awaiting arraignment in court or trial, while 1,858 were awaiting sentence. 5,837 are fugitives and 316 in other status beyond the control of the United States Attorneys.

#### GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury proceedings, comprised of 21,412 indictments and 119 No True Bills, amounted to 21,531, a decrease of 9.28 percent less than the previous fiscal year.

#### CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received decreased to 158,501, this is 7.59 percent less than the 171,518 received in fiscal year 1976. California Southern with 21,480 had the most complaints and California Central with 5,812 and New Jersey with 4,128 were the next highest. 76,039 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

PENDING - Criminal Complaints pending as of September 30, 1977 rose to 35,215 an increase of 2,085 or 6.29 percent more than the 33,130 pending as of September 30, 1976.

CLOSED - 117,964 Complaints were closed during 1977 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 100,496 or 85.19 percent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

#### CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil Cases filed amounted to 49,217 a decrease of 255 or .52 percent less than the previous year's total. 48 districts had increases and 46 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 20,520 or 41.69 percent of the total was in fifteen districts having filings ranging from 1,020 to 1,876, Tax Lien cases with 6,325, Tort cases with 2,882 and General Claims cases with 3,763 had 12.85, 5.86 and 7.65 percent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED. - With 56 districts showing increases and 38 districts with decreases, civil cases terminated increased to 40,323. This total is over fiscal year 1976 total by 3,660 or 9.98 percent.

7,712 of these cases were suits in which the Government as defendant was sued for \$783,854,083. 591 of them involving \$345,693,055 were closed by compromise amounting to \$65,935,364 and 1,333 involving \$259,040,494 resulting in judgments against the Government amounting to \$18,791,293. The remaining 5,788 cases involving \$179,120,534 were won by the Government, thus bringing the savings to \$695,722,610 an increase of \$288,562,493 or 70.87 percent from the \$407,160,117 saved in Fiscal Year 1976.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 8,894 or 14.90 percent to 68,564. 35,540 or 51.82 percent of the caseload was in eighteen districts with caseloads ranging from 1,176 in Florida Middle to 3,912 in New York Eastern. Tax Lien cases with 9,550 increased to 13.93 percent of the total as compared to 8,777 or 14.71 percent of the total pending as of September 30, 1976. Land cases with 2,910 or 4.24 percent increased from 2,346 or 3.93 percent of the total.

#### CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil Matters received amounted to 57,259 an increase of 1,440 or 2.57 percent more than the 55,819 in Fiscal Year 1976. Tax Lien matters with 6,365 and Tort

matters with 2,976 comprised 11.11 percent and 5.20 percent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 5,287 or 9.23 percent of the total. 26,619 or 46.49 percent of the total was in seventeen districts having totals ranging from 1,056 in Missouri Western to 2,318 in California Central.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 5,473 an increase of 773 or 14.12 percent more than the fiscal year 1976 total of 4,700.

PENDING - 14,552 civil matters were pending as of September 30, 1977 as compared to 11,983 as of September 30, 1976. This is an increase of 2,569 or 21.43 percent.

#### MAN-HOURS

A total of 509,209 man-hours were spent in court during fiscal year 1977. This is a decrease of 42,209 or 7.65 percent less than Fiscal Year 1976. Following is a breakdown of those hours.

Based on an average employment of 1386 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 30.61 hours per month in courtroom work during the fiscal year. This compares with an average of 34.22 hours per month in Fiscal Year 1976.

#### COLLECTIONS

Collections for Fiscal Year 1977 amounted to \$216,732,902, an increase of \$38,613,801 or 21.67 percent more than the \$178,119,101 collected in Fiscal Year 1976.

#### PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 3,286 employees and 3,278 were on the rolls as of September 30, 1977. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney increased from 123.1 in Fiscal Year 1976 to 125.7 in the current year while cases terminated decreased from 61.3 to 58.8.

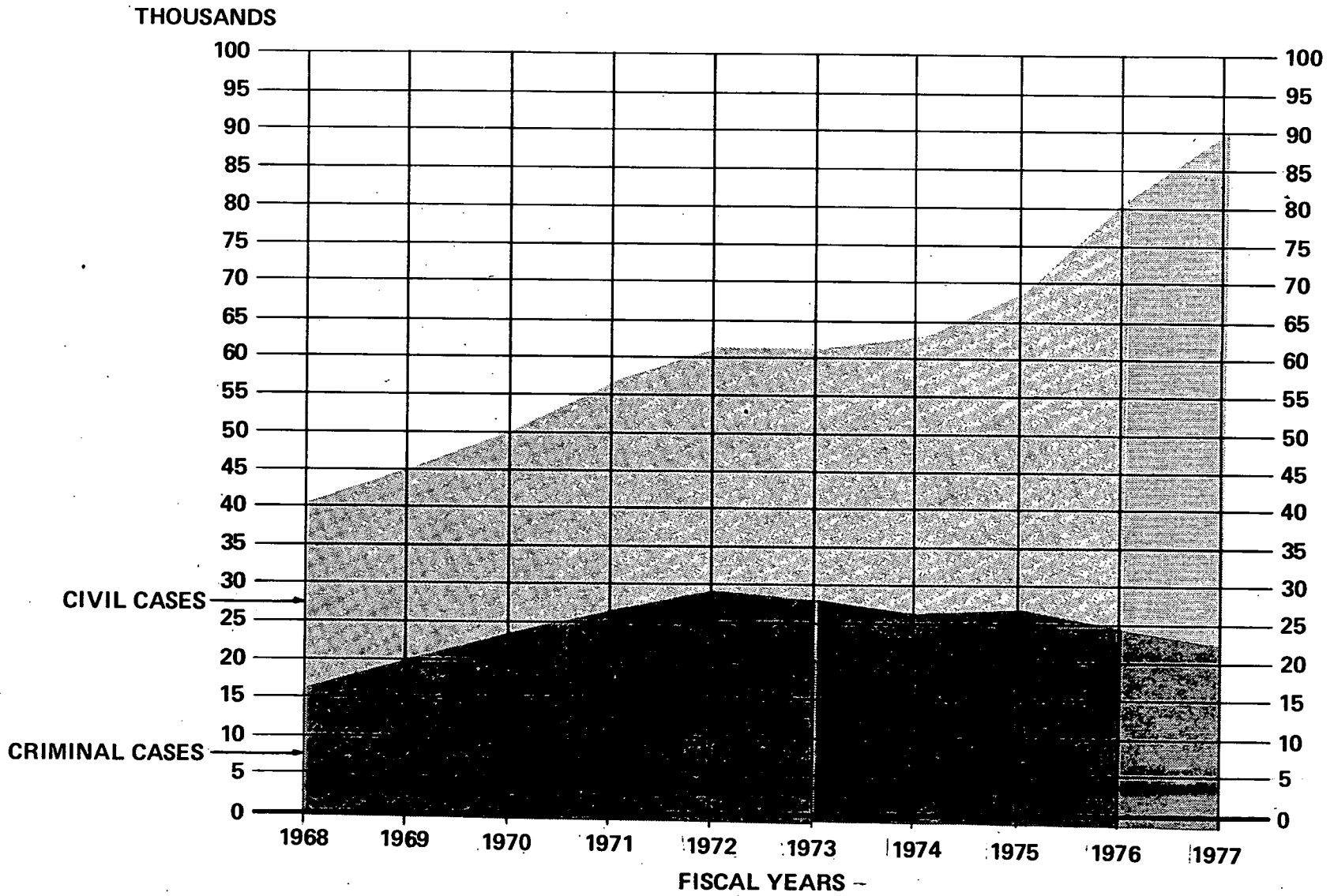

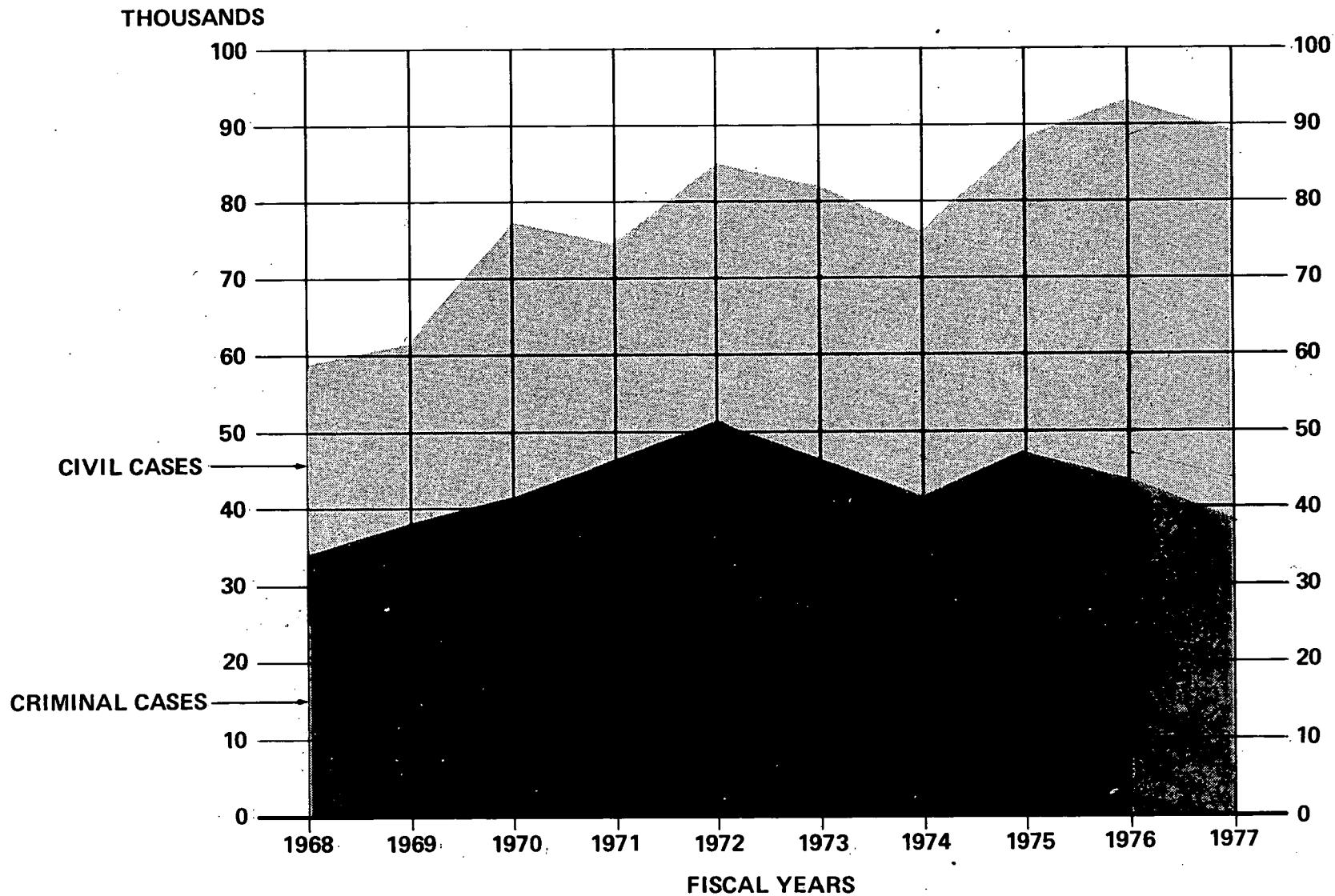

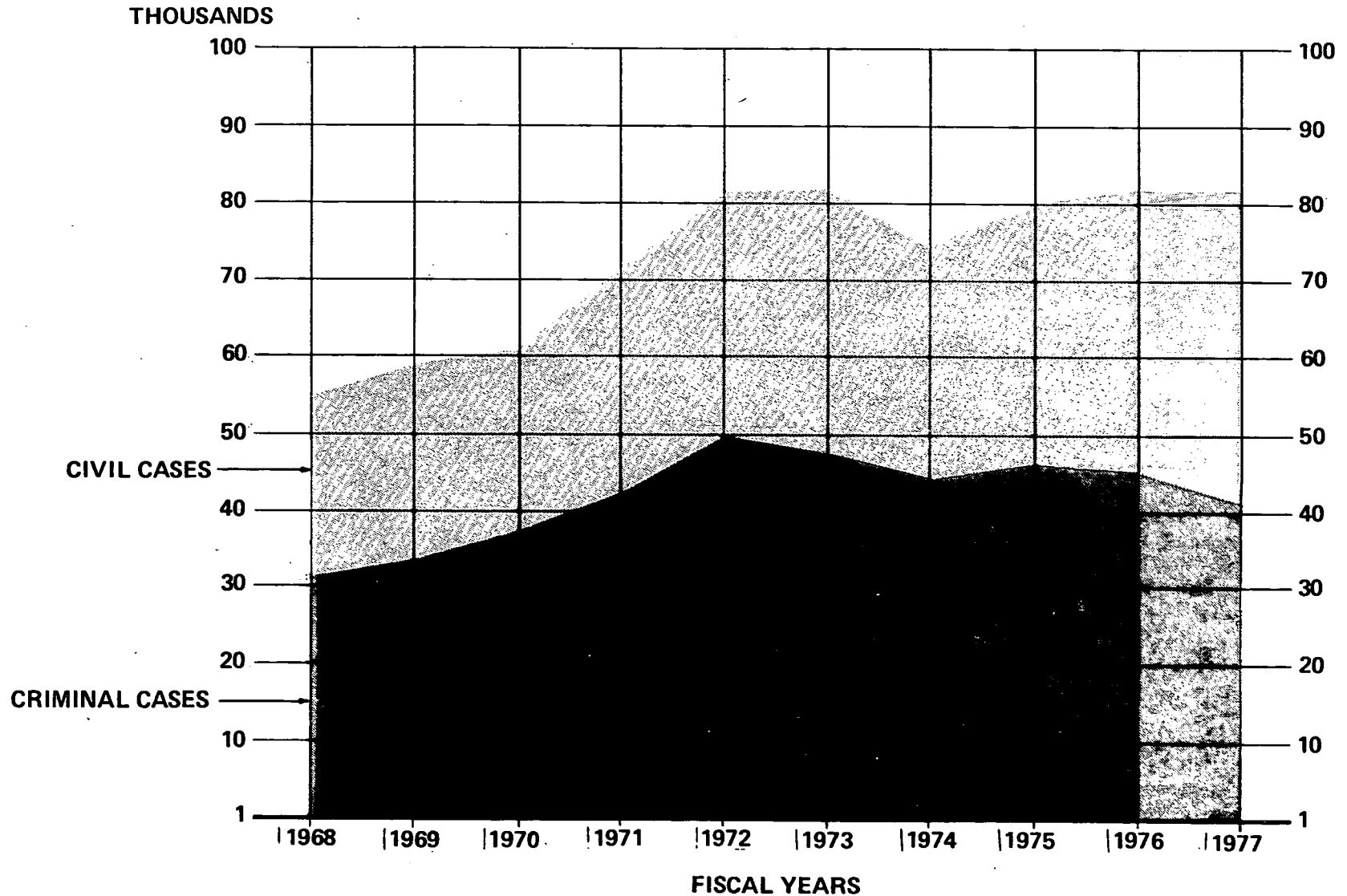
**Chart 1** Cases Pending

United States Attorneys' Offices



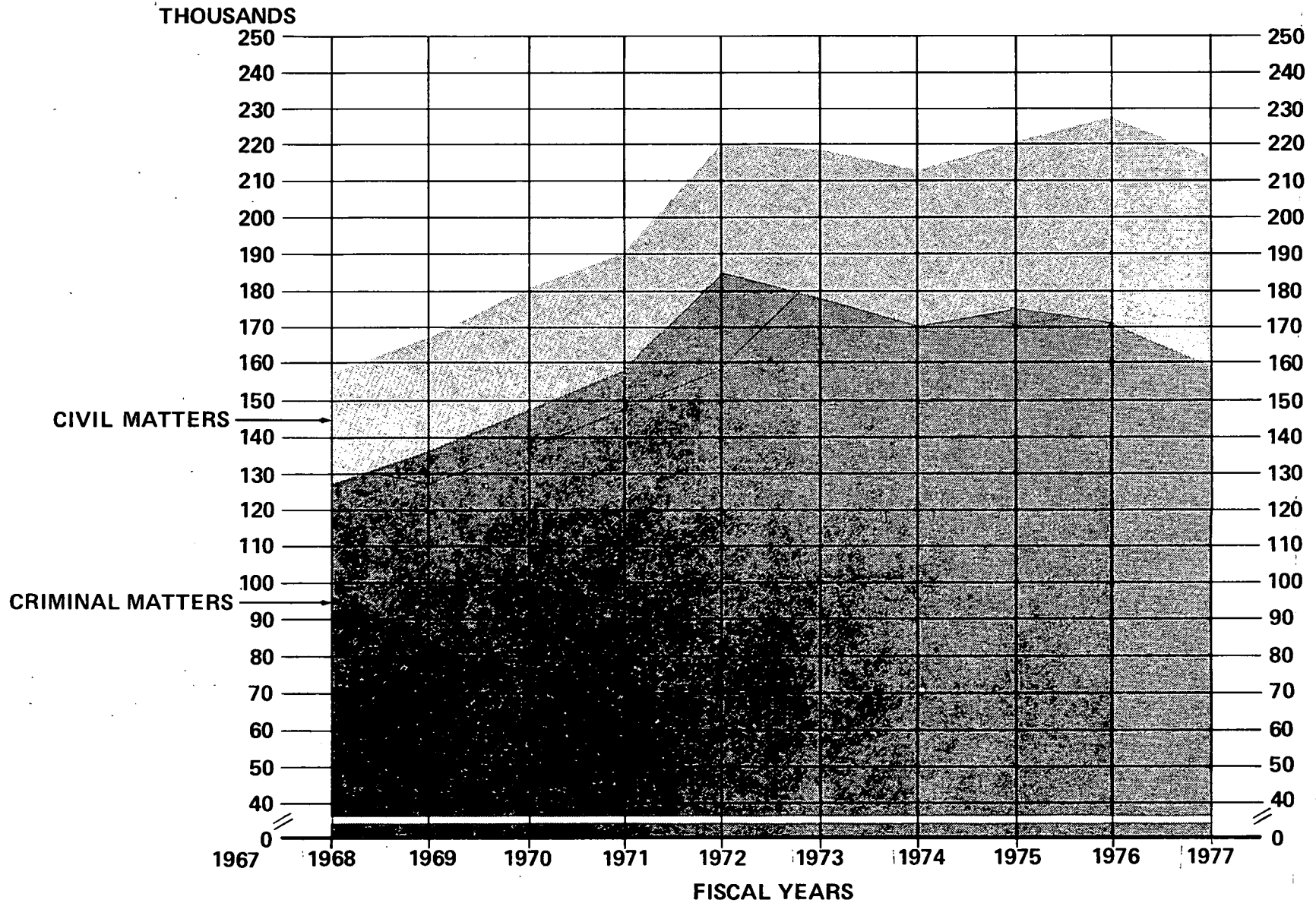
**Chart 2 | Criminal and Civil Cases

United States Attorneys' Offices**



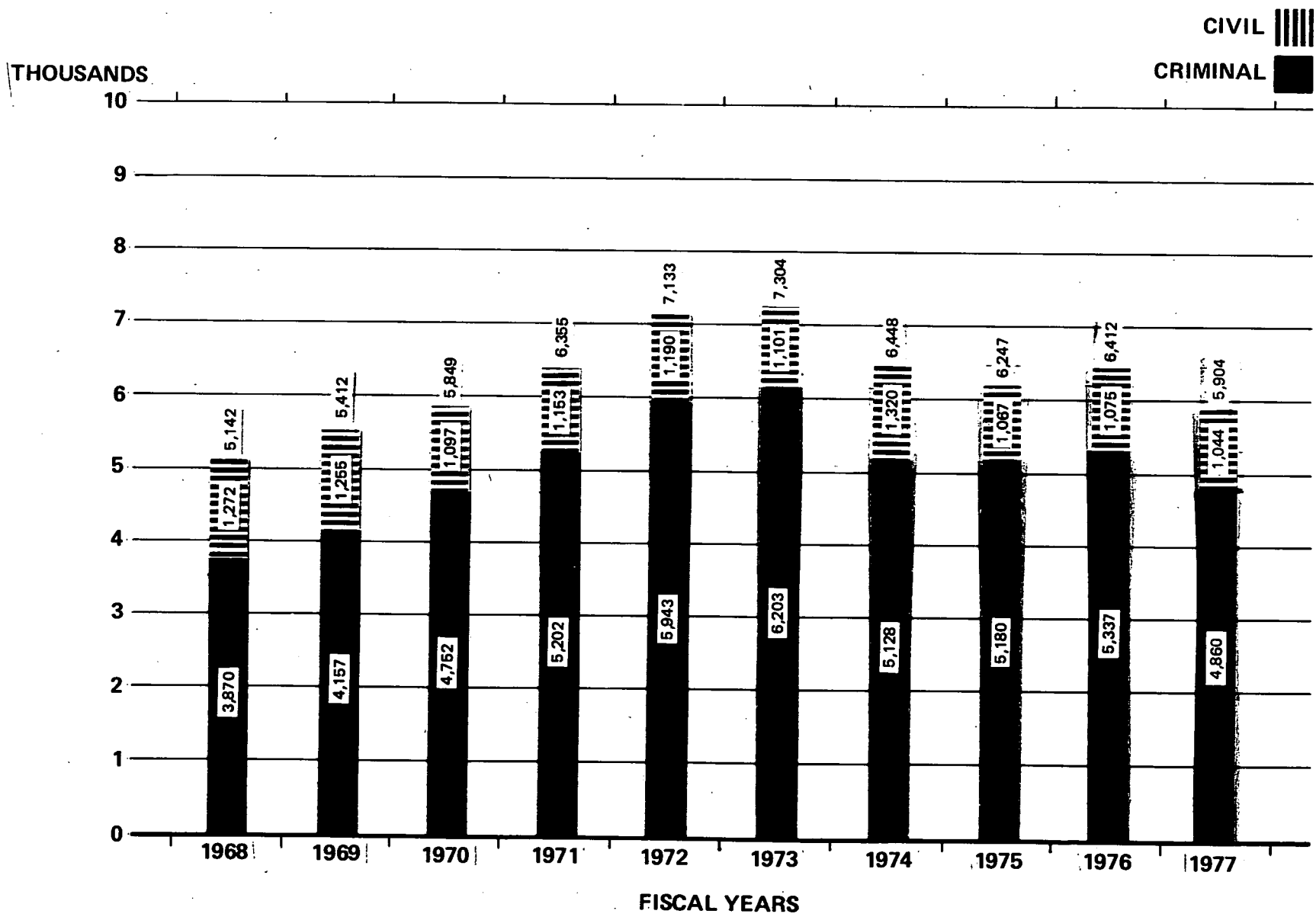
**Chart 3 | Criminal and Civil Cases

United States Attorney's' Offices**



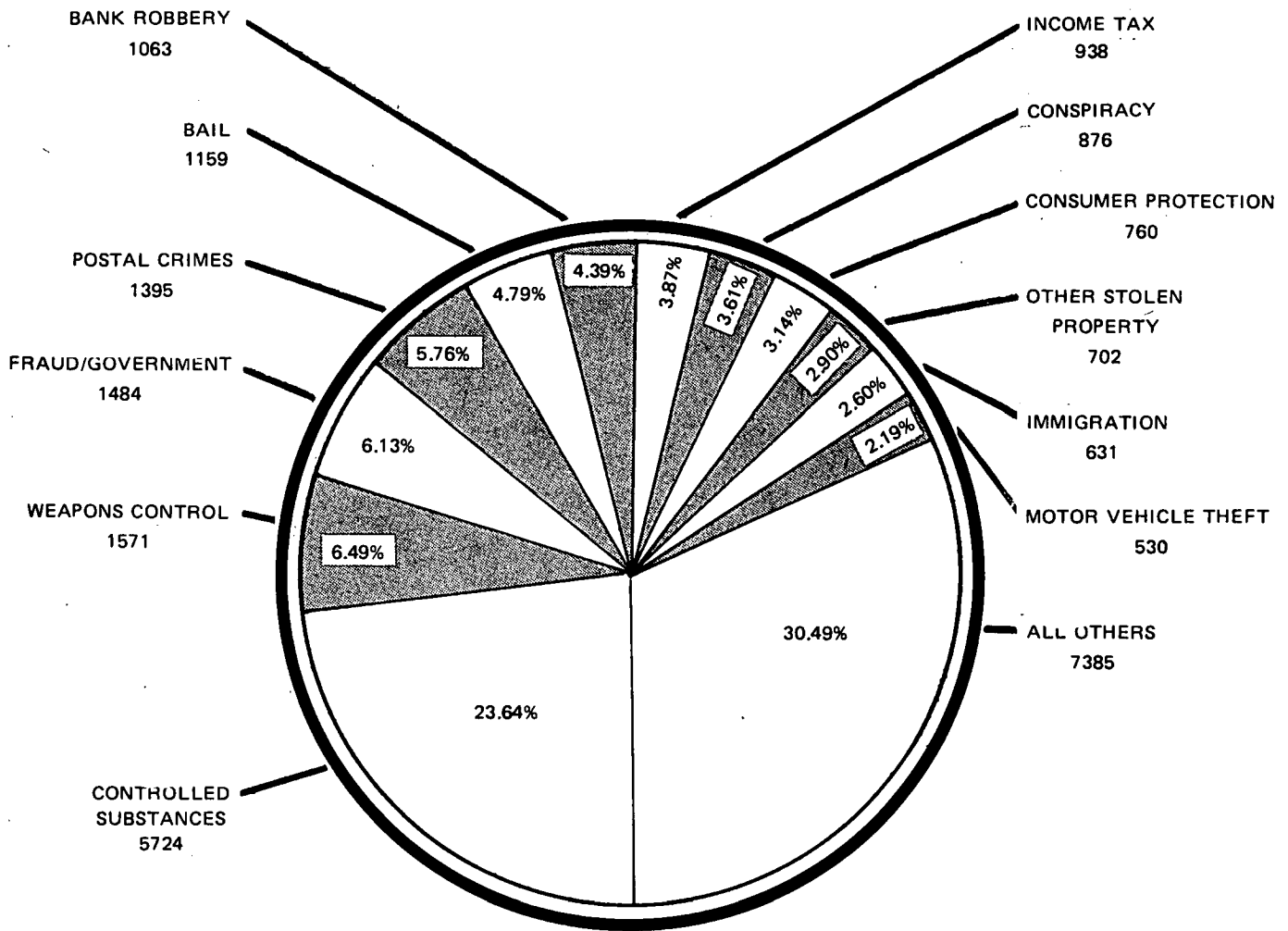
**Chart 4 Criminal and Civil Matters

United States Attorneys' Offices**



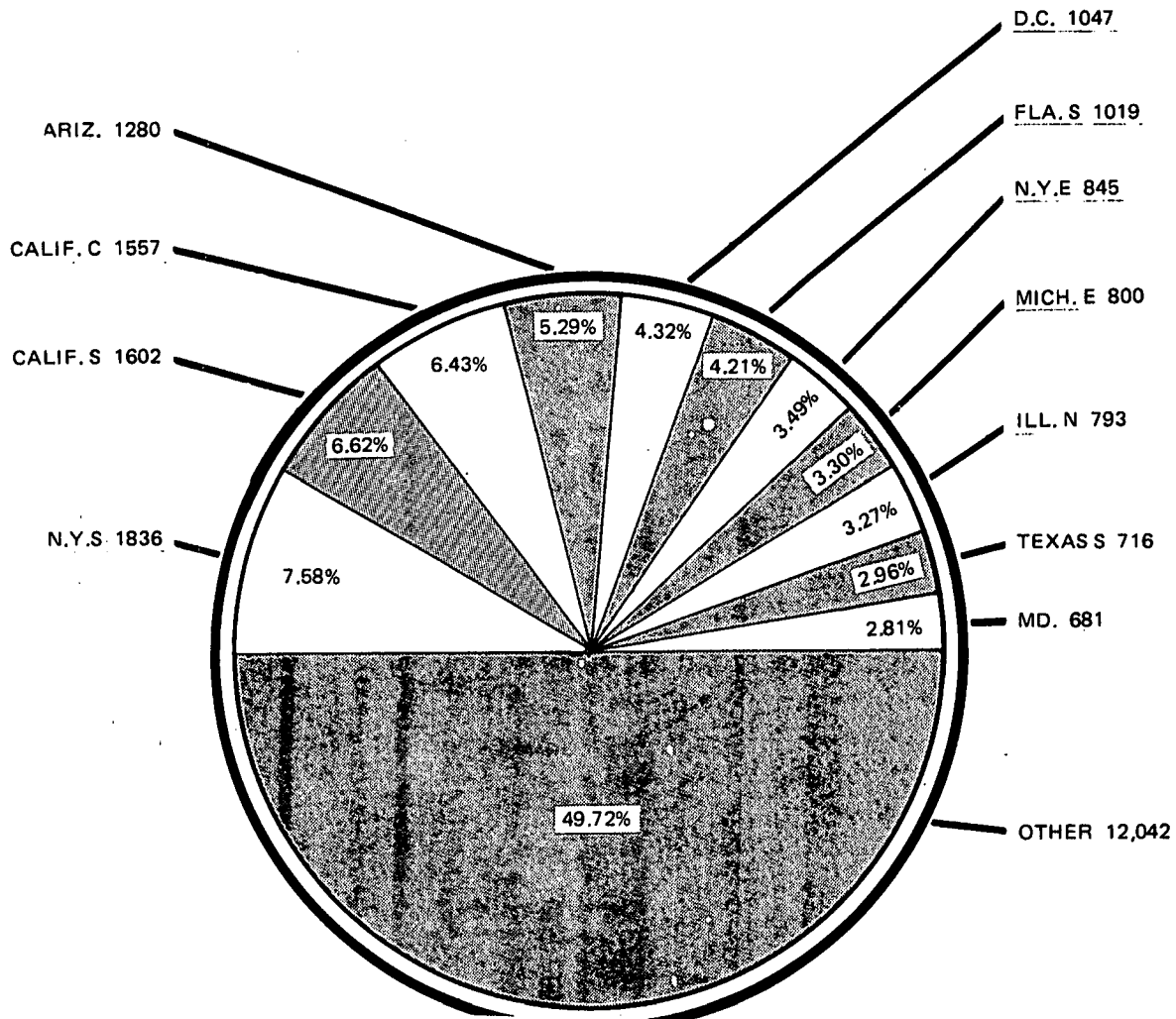
**Chart 6 | Criminal Cases Pending

Total 24,218 Cases**



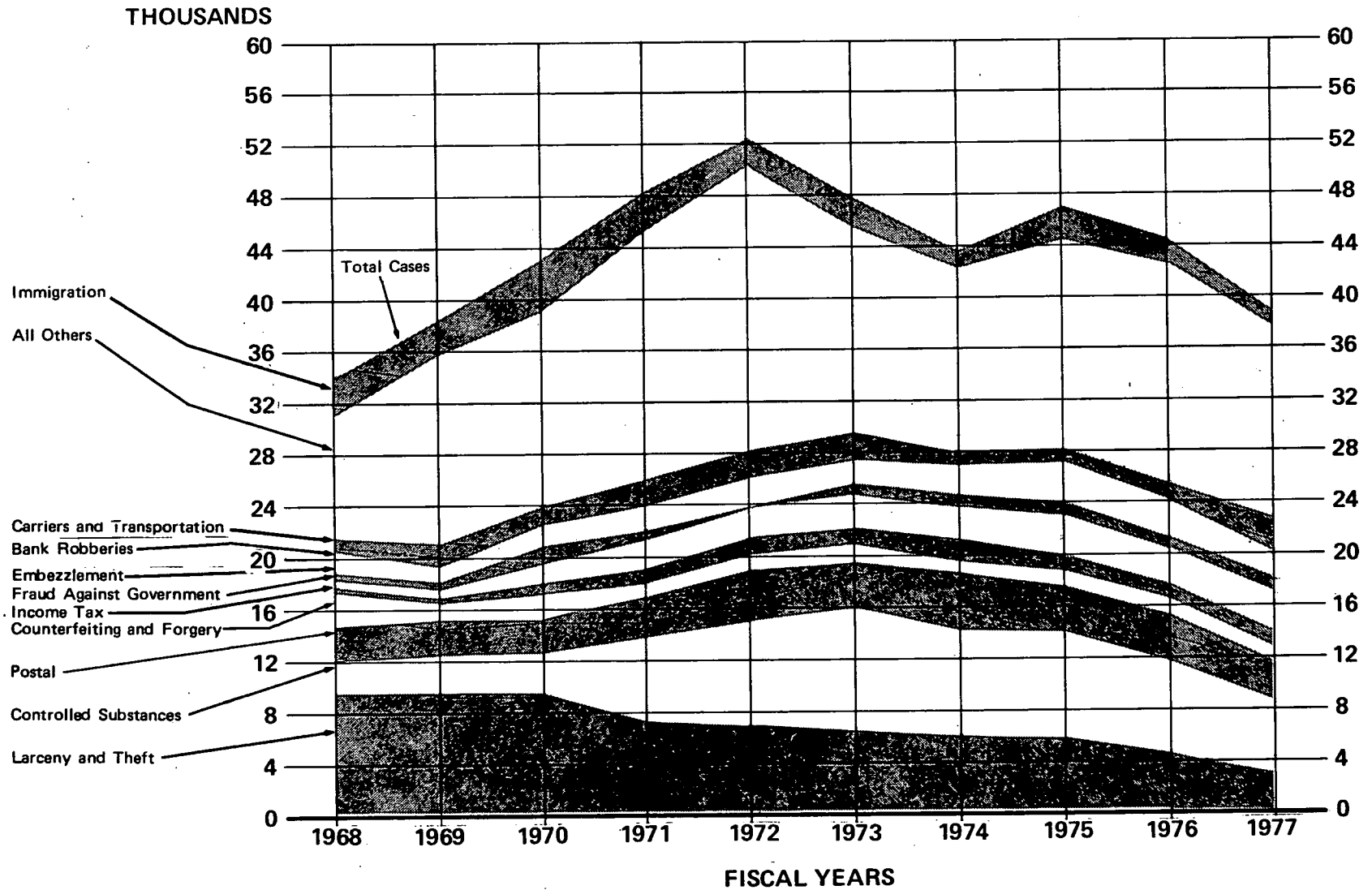


# Chart 7 Criminal Cases Pending in United States Attorneys' Offices

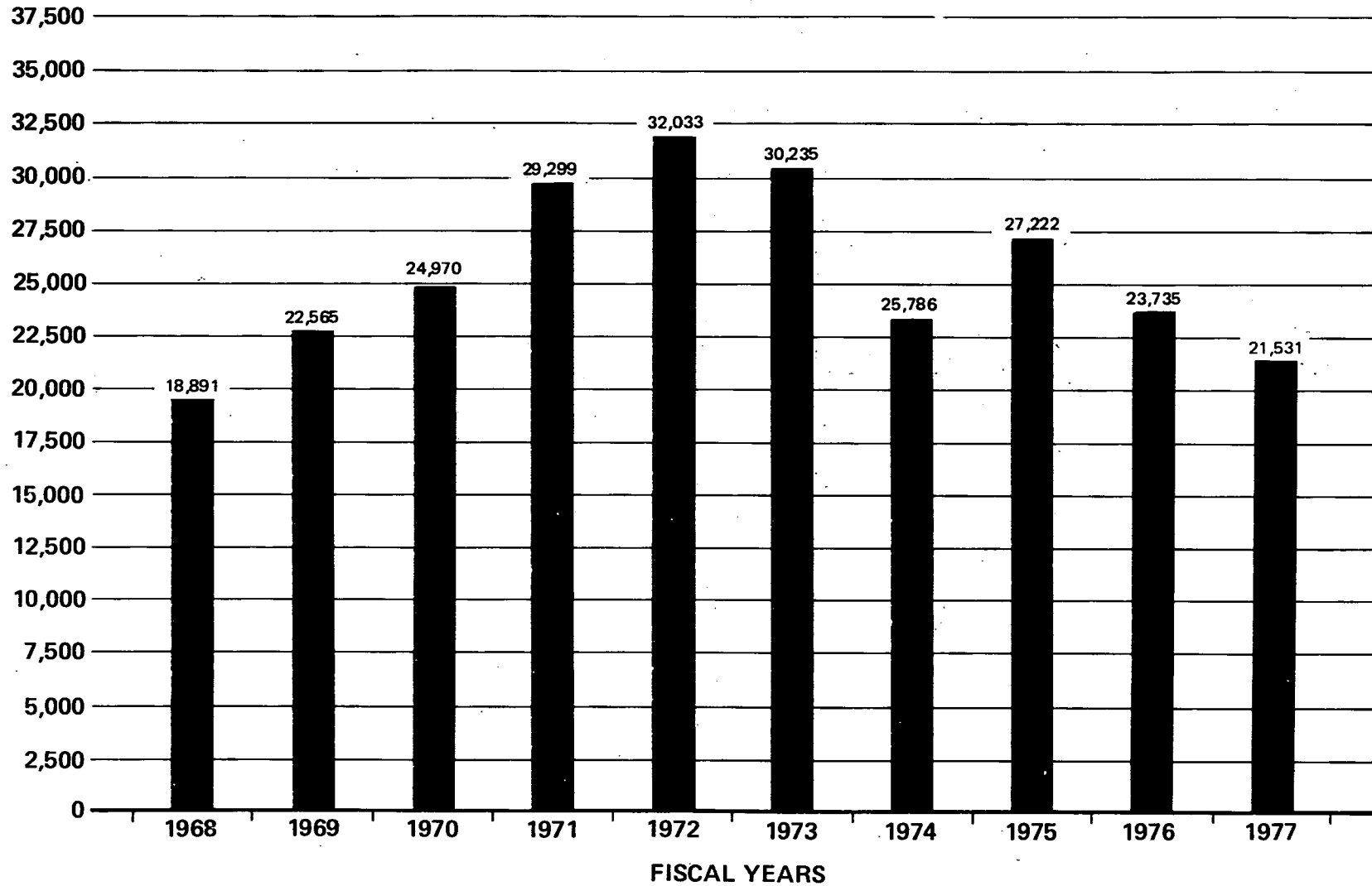


# Chart 8 | Criminal Cases Filed in United States Attorneys' Offices



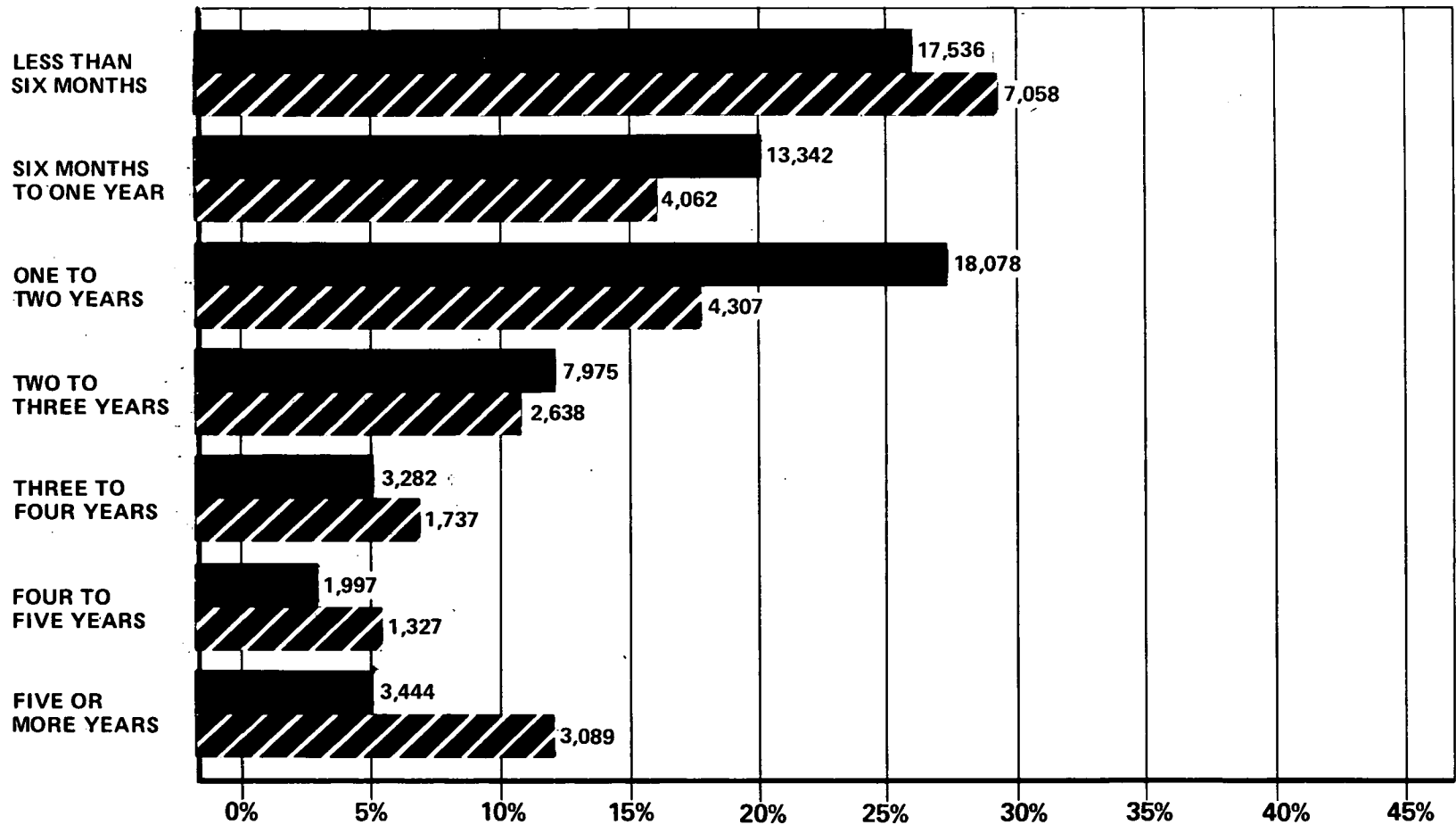
**Chart 9 | Proceedings Before Grand Jury in

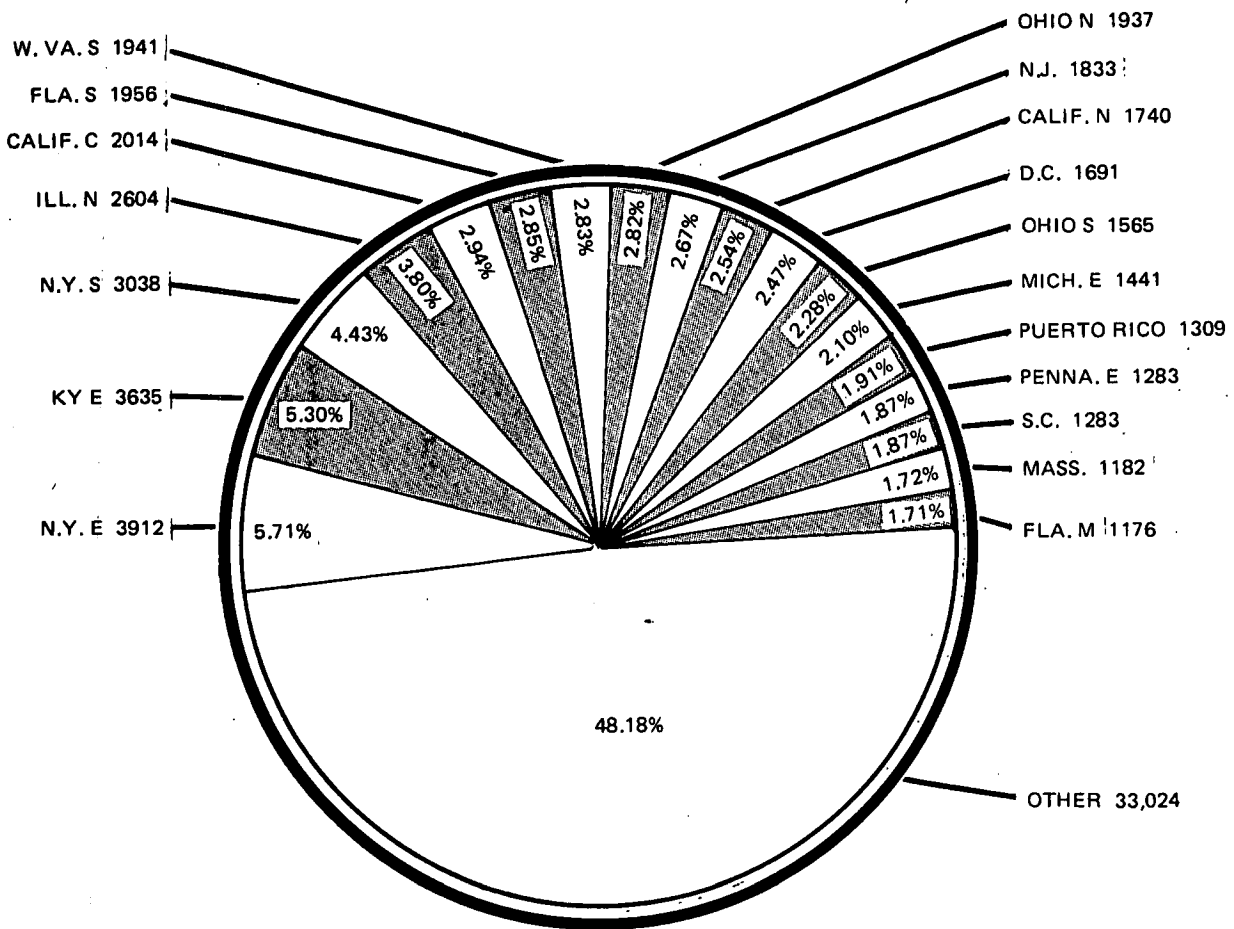


**Chart 10 | Age of Criminal and Civil Cases Pending in

Total Cases Criminal 24,218      Civil 65,654**

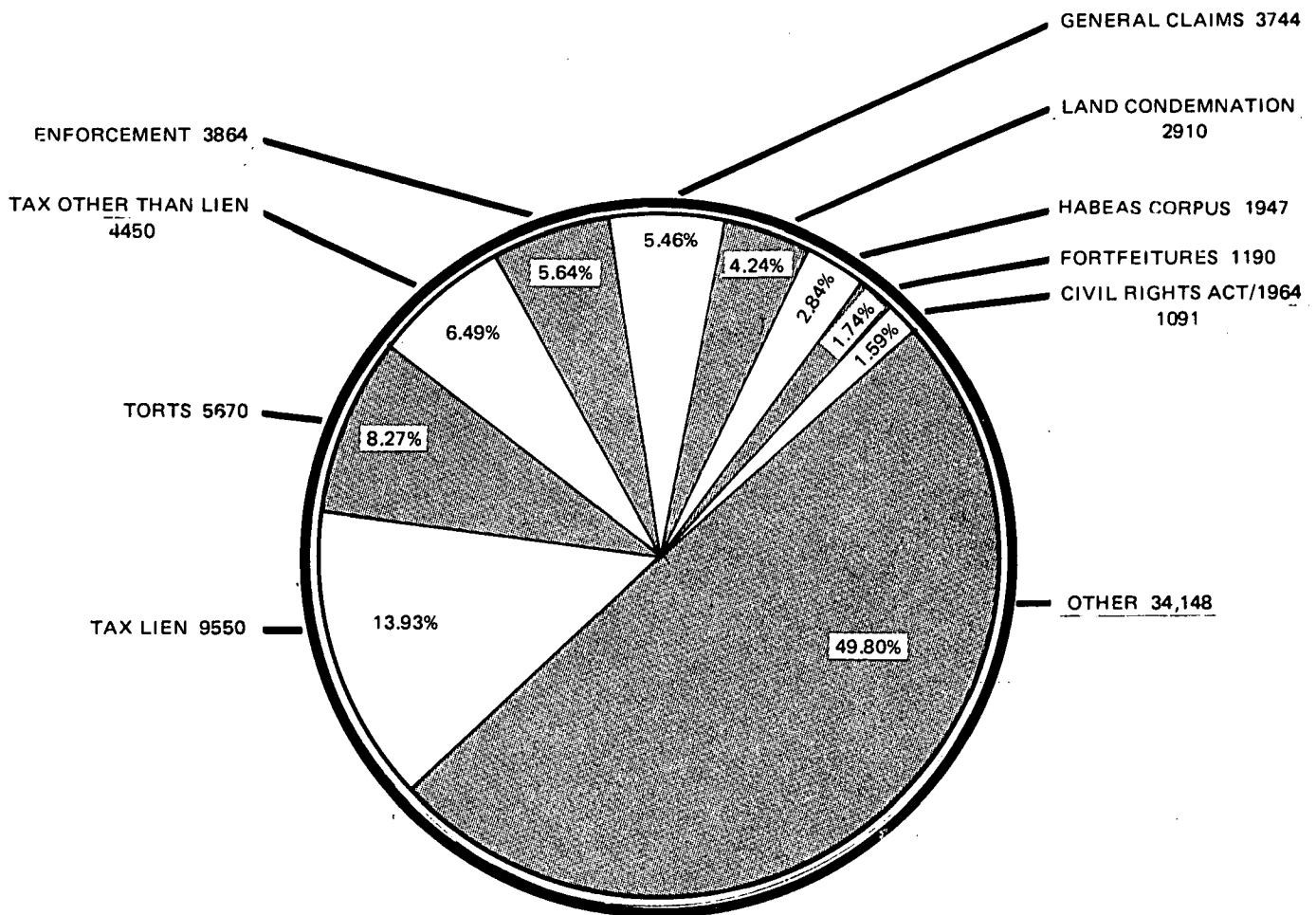

Total 68,564 Cases**

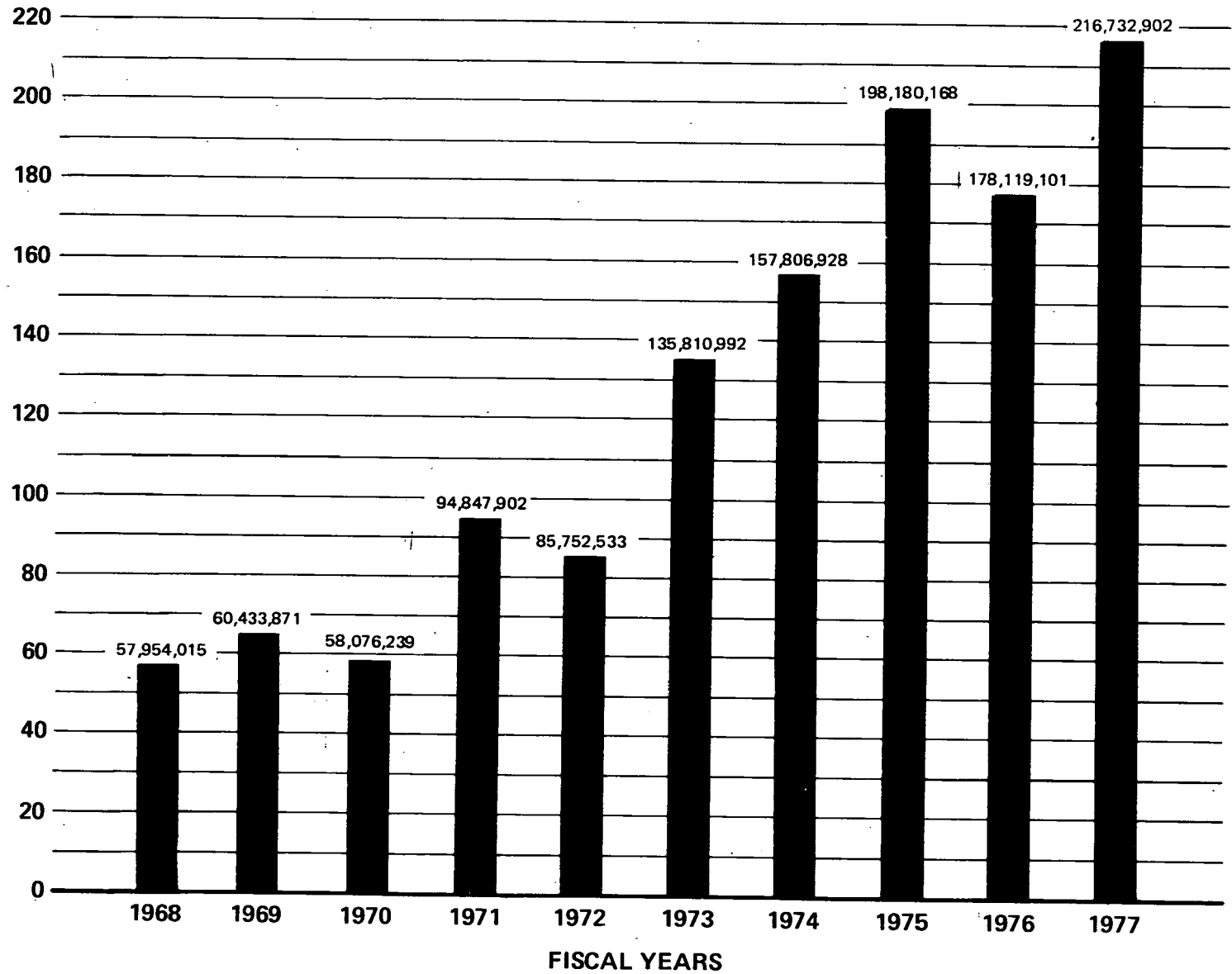


**Chart 12 | Civil Cases Pending

Total 68,564 Cases**

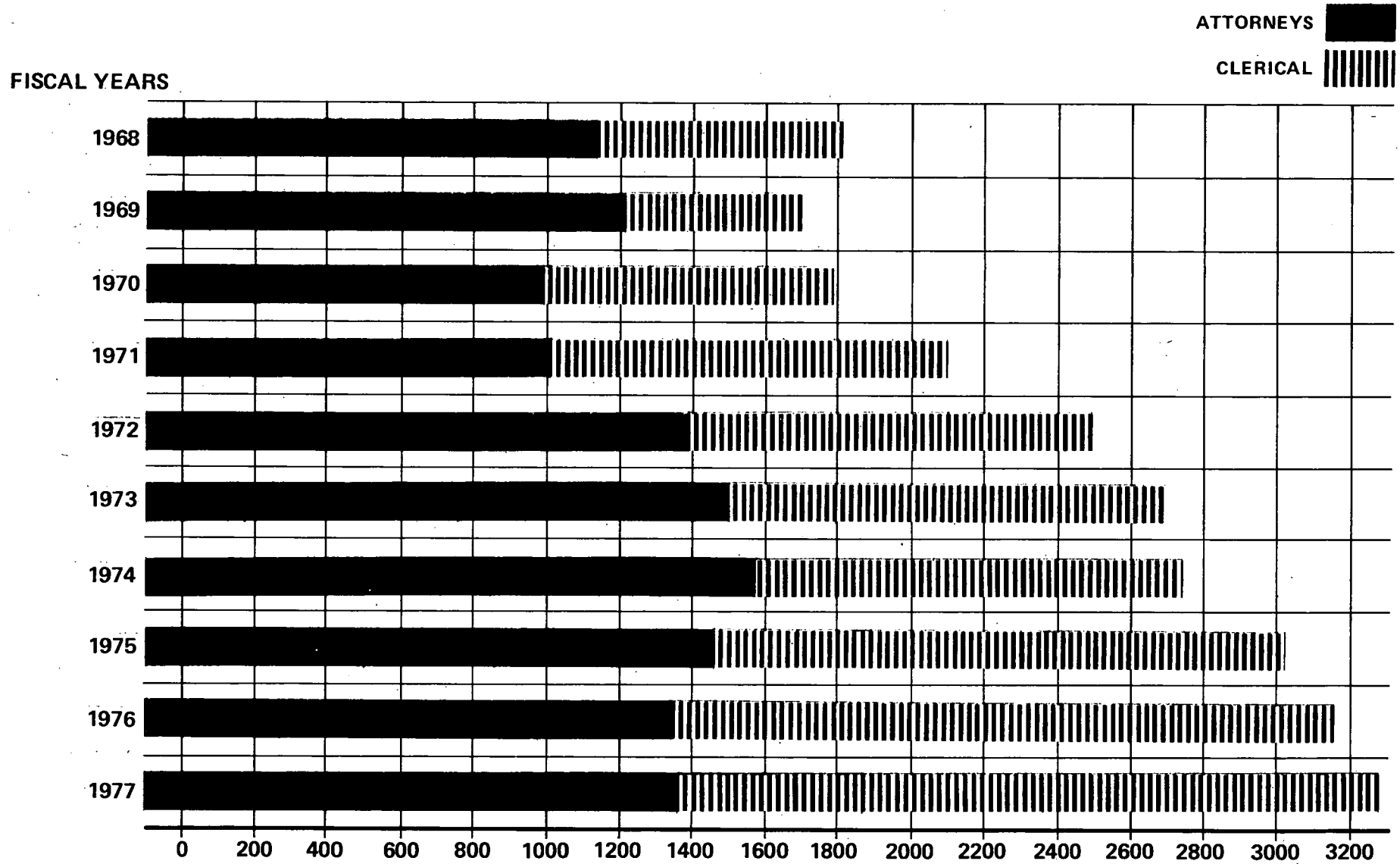


# Chart 13 | Collections in United States Attorneys' Offices
