FEDERAL GRAND JURY INDICTMENTS

Columbia, South Carolina ---- United States Attorney Bill Nettles announced today that a Federal Grand Jury sitting in Charleston, South Carolina, has returned the following indictments:

Aggravated Felon Indicted in Charleston

Charleston, South Carolina ---- Mario Tinoco, age 32, of Mexico, was charged in a 1-count Indictment with the Illegal Re-entry of an Aggravated Felon, a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326. The maximum penalty that Mario Tinoco could receive is 20 years imprisonment. The case was investigated by agents of the Immigration and Customs Enforcement and is assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Rhett DeHart of the Charleston office for prosecution.

Goose Creek Man Indicted for Counterfeiting

Aaron D. Green, age 20, of Goose Creek, was charged in a 2-count Indictment with Making and Passing Counterfeit Currency, a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 471 and 472. The maximum penalty that Aaron D. Green could receive is 20 years imprisonment. The case was investigated by agents of the United States Secret Service and the Goose Creek Police Department and is assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Rhett DeHart of the Charleston office for prosecution.

Aggravated Felon Indicted in Charleston

Mario Guadarrama, age 49, of Mexico, was charged in a 1-count Indictment with the Illegal Re-entry of an Aggravated Felon, a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326. The maximum penalty that Mario Guadarrama could receive is 20 years imprisonment. The case was investigated by agents of the Immigration and Customs Enforcement and is assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Rhett DeHart of the Charleston office for prosecution.
