## **BLACKVILLE COUPLE FACE FRAUD CHARGES**

Columbia, South Carolina – United States Attorney W. Walter Wilkins stated today that a federal grand jury has indicted Stacy Duncan Delk, age 32, and Kelly P. Delk, age 31, both of Blackville, South Carolina, for credit card fraud, a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1029(a)(2). Stacy Delk was also charged with six counts of aggravated identity theft, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1028A. Authorities allege that while working at an Aiken car dealership, Stacy Delk stole customers' identification information, and then used it to obtain credit cards and open credit accounts. The Delks allegedly made purchases of more than \$18,000.00 with the unauthorized credit cards.

Stacy Delk could receive a maximum sentence of 22 years in prison. Kelly Delk faces a maximum possible sentence of ten years. Both could be

fined \$250,000.00.

This case was investigated by agents of the United States Secret Service and is assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Dean A. Eichelberger of the Columbia office for prosecution.

The United States Attorney stated that all charges in this Indictment are merely accusations and that the Defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
