## **EASLEY, GREER, FOUNTAIN INN, SIX MILE RESIDENTS INDICTED**

COLUMBIA, South Carolina - - United States Attorney Reginald I. Lloyd announced today that a Federal Grand Jury in Greenville, South Carolina, returned a one-count Indictment charging RUSSELL DAY, age 42, and ALLISON JOHNSON, age 37, both of Easley, STEPHEN HERLONG, age 36, of Six Mile, AMANDA ROGERS, age 27, of Greer, South Carolina, JENNIFER BOBO, age 26, of Fountain Inn, BRITTANI HICKS, age 19, of Charleston, and DARLENE ROBBINS, age 46, of Bradenton, Florida, with conspiracy to make and pass counterfeit checks, a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 371.

The Indictment alleges that the group passed counterfeit payroll checks to various businesses throughout the upstate between August 2006 and February 2007.

The maximum penalty for this offense is a fine of \$250,000.00 and imprisonment of five years.

This case was investigated by agents of the United States Secret Service and has been assigned to Assistant United States Attorney W. Walter Wilkins of the Greenville Office for prosecution.

The United States Attorney stated that all charges in this Indictment are merely accusations and that all defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
