**SAN ANTONIO MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO  
DISTRIBUTION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY**

**United States Attorney Johnny Sutton** announced today that 33-year-old Dennis Joseph Jasso of San Antonio faces between five and 20 years in federal prison after pleading guilty today to a child pornography charge.

Appearing before United States Magistrate Judge Nancy Stein Nowak, Jasso pleaded guilty to one count of distribution of child pornography.

On December 21, 2007, FBI agents executed a search warrant at the defendant's residence and seized his personal computer and related media. A subsequent forensic examination revealed the presence of over 20,000 images depicting minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct.

Sentencing is scheduled for May 28, 2009, before United States District Judge Orlando Garcia.

This case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Assistant United States Attorney Tracy Braun is prosecuting this case on behalf of the Government.
