Madison, Wisconsin -- Erik C. Peterson, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Mauricio Olivares-Torres, 28, a citizen of Mexico, was sentenced yesterday by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to 57 months in prison for illegally re-entering the United States. Olivares-Torres pleaded guilty to this offense on February 11, 2009.

Olivares-Torres was first deported from the United States in 2004 after being convicted in Rock County Circuit Court of first degree sexual assault of a child.

Olivares-Torres admitted to law enforcement officers that he returned to the United States in June 2008. He was found in Rock County in August 2008.

The charge against Olivares-Torres was the result of an investigation conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Paul W. Connell.
