Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Gregory L. Parker, 29, Madison, Wis., was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to ten years in prison for possession with intent to distribute crack cocaine. Parker pleaded guilty to this charge on June 4, 2009.

On February 18, 2009, police officers found Parker in possession of approximately 60 grams of crack cocaine. A subsequent search of Parker's apartment uncovered over 200 grams of crack cocaine, a loaded firearm, and 49 rounds of ammunition.

The charges against Parker were the result of an investigation conducted by the Dane County Gang and Drug Task Force. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney David J. Reinhard.
