Man Sentenced for Cocaine Distribution in Rhinelander Area

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that David J. Curby, 41, Madison, Wis., was sentenced today by Senior U.S. District Judge James T. Moody to 151 months in federal prison for distribution of cocaine in the Rhinelander area. Curby pleaded guilty to this charge on April 1, 2009.

In February 2008, Curby distributed approximately three ounces of cocaine in three clandestine transactions with law enforcement. Curby's lengthy sentence was based, in part, on his three prior felony drug distribution convictions.

This conviction was a result of an investigation conducted by the Oneida County Sheriff's Department. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Robert A. Anderson.
