Man Sentenced for Illegal Entry into United States

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Gonzalo Perez-Moreno, 35, a citizen of Mexico, was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge James T. Moody, a visiting judge from the Northern District of Indiana, to 77 months in prison, without the possibility of parole, for intentionally re-entering the United States after previously being deported. Perez-Moreno pleaded guilty to this charge on March 31, 2009.

Perez-Moreno was deported to Mexico in 2004 and he was arrested in Arizona when he re-entered the United States in September 2008. Perez-Moreno's 77 month sentence reflects the fact that he was previously convicted of 3rd degree sexual assault, an aggravated felony.

The charge against Perez-Moreno was the result of an investigation conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Rita M. Rumbelow.
