Federal Prison Inmate Charged with Assault

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that a federal grand jury sitting in Madison returned an indictment today charging Michael S. Adair, 40, an inmate of the Federal Correctional Institution at Oxford, Wis., with assaulting another prisoner with a deadly weapon and with the intent to cause bodily harm. The indictment alleges that the assault occurred on June 13, 2009.

If convicted, Adair faces a maximum penalty of ten years in federal prison. The charge against him is the result of an investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The prosecution of this case has been assigned to Assistant U.S. Attorney Peter M. Jarosz.

You are advised that a charge is merely an accusation and that a defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
