**MEXICAN CITIZEN SENTENCED TO FEDERAL PRISON**  
**FOR ILLEGAL RE-ENTRY INTO UNITED STATES**

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Armando Leon-Reyes, 48, a citizen of Mexico who was living in Madison, Wis., was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Lynn S. Adelman to 52 months in prison for illegally re-entering the United States after having been previously deported. Leon-Reyes pleaded guilty to this charge on August 6, 2009.

Judge Adelman explained that the 52-month sentence was the result of the defendant's lengthy criminal history. Specifically, Judge Adelman noted that Leon-Reyes had prior convictions for robbery, burglary, vehicle theft, and aggravated battery.

The charges against Leon-Reyes were the result of an investigation conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney David J. Reinhard.
