STOUGHTON WOMAN SENTENCED TO PROBATION FOR BANK EMBEZZLEMENT

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Heather Jackson, 21, of Stoughton, Wis., was sentenced yesterday by U.S. Magistrate Judge Stephen L. Crocker to one year of probation for embezzling money from her former employer, Anchor Bank. Jackson pleaded guilty to this charge on August 25, 2009.

In July 2008, while Ms. Jackson was a teller at the Fitchburg branch of Anchor Bank, she took \$2,048 from her cash drawer. She will be required to pay restitution in this amount while she is on probation.

The charges against Jackson were the result of an investigation conducted by the Fitchburg Police Department. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Elizabeth Altman.
