**STEVENS POINT MAN SENTENCED FOR
FALSE STATEMENT ON FIREARMS PURCHASE FORM**

Madison, Wis. - Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Charles Millard, 66, Stevens Point, Wis., was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to four months in prison for knowingly making a false statement on an ATF Form 4473, firearms transaction record. Millard pleaded guilty to this charge on June 24, 2009.

The investigation revealed that the defendant knowingly made a false statement on the federal firearms purchase form provided to Apache Road Gun Sales in Plainfield, Wis., on October 5, 2007, to purchase an Olympic Arms, Model K16, .223 caliber rifle. The defendant was not the actual purchaser of the semi-automatic rifle, as he represented on the form, but was purchasing the rifle for an individual who had previously been convicted of a felony offense.

The charge against Millard was the result of an investigation conducted by the Portage County Sheriff's Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Rita M. Rumbelow.
