Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §521(a)(1)(B)(iv), the debtor is required to file with the court copies of all payment advices received within 60 days of filing the petition. In addition, Interim Rule 4002(b)(2)(A) requires the debtor to "bring evidence of current income such as the most recent pay advices" to the §341 Meeting. A review of the above-referenced case indicates that you have not filed the required pay advices for the debtor. Please electronically file the appropriate pay advices in the above-referenced case immediately and mail copies of the pay advices to this office and to the Chapter 7 trustee. You reviewed the pay advices when you prepared the Means Test Calculation Form B22A, so these documents should already be in your file.

In addition, a preliminary review of the Chapter 7 voluntary petition filed with the Court on reveals that these are not the only deficiencies. According to the PACER docket, you have been notified of such deficiencies and have yet to satisfy the deficiency. WE ARE REQUIRING AN IMMEDIATE REPLY. Please provide the requested information to both the trustee and this office, at least five days prior to the 341 Meeting of creditors scheduled for
