Most of the time, when cases are converted to chapter 7 rather than dismissed, it is because there is an asset, issue, or conduct that warrants investigation or pending litigation to be resolved. Therefore, the United States Trustee requests chapter 7 trustees not employ the "NFTA" procedures under General Order 2-2005 to dismiss the case on account of a debtor's failure to appear in a converted case. If you contend dismissal for failure to appear is appropriate, please file a motion under 707(a) or refer the case to this office. Thank you.
