

## Justice Property Transferred to Non-Federal Agencies by Type Fiscal Year 2025

**Note:**

As part of the [Civil Asset Forfeiture Reform Act \(CAFRA\) of 2000](#), title 28, United States Code, section 524(c) was amended, in pertinent part, to provide the following:

(6)(A) The Attorney General shall transmit to Congress and make available to the public, not later than 4 months after the end of each fiscal year, detailed reports for the prior fiscal year as follows:

(iv) A report describing the number, value, and types of property transferred to State and local law enforcement agencies, by recipient agency.

However, in 2023, the Department of Justice eliminated these types of transfers. “The transfer of forfeited tangible or real property to a state, local, or tribal law enforcement agency through the equitable sharing program is prohibited.” See [Asset Forfeiture Policy Manual \(2025\), Chap. 15, Sec..II.A.3](#).
