The Department of Justice today filed a civil antitrust suit against the Laramie County Liquor Dealers Association, a trade association of retail liquor dealers in Laramie, Wyoming.

Acting Attorney General Charles B. Renfrew said the suit, which charges the Association with violating Section 1 of the Sherman Act, was filed in United States District Court in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Sanford M. Litvack, Assistant Attorney General in charge of the Antitrust Division, said the complaint alleges that since at least as early as 1968 the Association engaged in a conspiracy to restrain trade by preparing and distributing to retail liquor dealer members suggested retail price lists for the sale of beer, wine and liquor.

The suit seeks to enjoin the defendant from continuing the alleged conspiracy.
