PRESS RELEASE

Susan W. Brooks, United States Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana, and Andrew G. Oosterbaan, Chief of the Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section of the U.S. Department of Justice, Criminal Division, announced that Jeffery Glen DIXON, 44, of Sheridan, Indiana, was sentenced to 180 months imprisonment today by U.S. District Judge John Daniel Tinder, following his guilty plea to production of child pornography.

On June 30, 2006, Jeffery Glen Dixon pled guilty in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana, Indianapolis, Indiana, to one count of Production of Child Pornography. The Government's evidence showed Dixon sexually abused a female relative under the age of 16, photographed the sexual abuse, and offered, through an online conversation, an opportunity for another person to sexually abuse the victim in exchange for \$100.00.

According to Assistant United States Attorney Steven D. DeBrotta and Trial Attorney Michael Yoon of the U.S. Department of Justice, Judge Tinder also imposed lifetime supervised

release following DIXON's release from imprisonment. DIXON was also ordered to make restitution in the amount of \$9,300. DIXON was taken into custody following the hearing.

This case was the result of a joint investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Fishers Police Department, the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department, the Hamilton County Prosecutor's Office, the U.S. Attorney's Office and the U.S. Department of Justice. The later Forensic examination of the computer evidence was conducted by Fishers Police Department and the Department of Justice High Tech Investigative Unit.

Dixon also pled guilty in Hamilton County Superior Court to one count of Child Molesting, an "A" felony, on July 27, 2006. Sentencing on that charge is set for August 24, 2006.
