On or about October 18, 2006, <sup>RLG</sup>in ~~Kabul~~, Afghanistan, the defendant, KHAN

MOHAMMED, did knowingly and intentionally distribute one kilogram or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I narcotic drug controlled substance, intending and knowing that such substance would be unlawfully imported into the United States; all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 959 (a)(1), 959(a)(2) and 960(b)(1)(A) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.




